1. The **three** main types of **learning** are **classical conditioning**, **operant conditioning**, and **observational learning**.
2. **Classical conditioning** is a type of **learning** in which a **neutral stimulus** is paired with an **unconditioned stimulus** to elicit a **conditioned response**.
