He was one of the most influential journalists in the United States in the late 19th century and, alongside his success as a horror writer, he was hailed as a pioneer of realism. Among his most famous works are *The Devil's Dictionary* and the short story *An Occurrence at Owl Creek Bridge*.

His vehemence as a critic, his motto "Nothing matters," and the sardonic view of human nature that informed his work all earned him the nickname "Bitter Bierce."
