DePlato, 2014-02-14 In this book Justin DePlato examines and analyzes the reasons and justifications for as well as instances of executive emergency power in political thought and action The book begins by analyzing the theory of executive emergency power across a wide breadth of philosophical history from Ancient Greek Renaissance through modern American political thought This analysis indicates that in political philosophy two models exist for determining and using executive emergency power an unfettered executive prerogative or a constitutional dictatorship The modern American approach to executive emergency power is an unfettered executive prerogative whereby the executive determines what emergency power is and how to use it The book addresses the fundamental question of whether executive power in times of crisis may be unfettered and discretionary or rather does the law define and restrain executive emergency power The author reviews and analyzes seven U S presidencies that handled a domestic crisis Washington Jefferson Madison Jackson Lincoln G W Bush and Obama to show that presidents become extraordinarily powerful during crises and act unilaterally without oversight The use of executive emergency power undermines the normal processes of democratic republicanism and harms the rule of law The author analyzes the U S Constitution formerly classified Department of Justice Memos primary sourced letters signing statements executive orders presidential decrees and original founding documents to comprehensively conclude that presidential prerogative determines what emergency powers are and how they are to be executed This book challenges the claim that presidents determine their emergency power with appropriate congressional oversight or consultation The analysis of the empirical data indicates that presidents do not consult with Congress prior to determining what their emergency powers are and how the president wants to use them Justin DePlato joins the highly contentious debate over the use of executive power during crisis and offers a sharp argument against an ever growing centralized and unchecked federal power He argues that presidents are becoming increasingly reckless when determining and using power during crisis often times acting unconstitutional

that the U S president alone embodies all executive power and therefore has unlimited ability to direct the many people and institutions within the federal government s vast executive branch It thus justifies the president s prerogative to organize the executive branch and to direct its activities to tell executive personnel what to do and to fire them if desired to control the flow of information and to issue signing statements that make judgments about constitutionality and determine the extent to which laws will be implemented In some versions it also endorses implied or inherent powers and permits the president to completely control foreign policy and military action Proponents say this conception of the presidential office is faithful to the Constitution facilitates the sort of energetic executive that Alexander Hamilton argued for and enhances administrative efficacy and political accountability for governance Critics say this arrangement is constitutionally inaccurate is belied by historical practice and legal precedents and is dangerously close to the monarchical power that provoked the American Revolution and can be especially threatening in the era of Donald Trump This book examines how controversies about unitary executive power have played out from the founding era to the present day with a focus on recent presidents it explores arguments both for and against the unitary executive theory and it looks ahead to future implications for American politics

A Editora Contracorrente tem a satisfação de anunciar a publicação do livro *O estado de exceção ou a impotência autoritária do Estado na era do liberalismo* da aclamada pensadora francesa Marie Goupy. Em sua densa obra cuja introdução e cuidadosa tradução para o português ficou a cargo de Victória Bianchi Okubo, a autora oferece um estudo aprofundado sobre o pensamento de Carl Schmitt. De acordo com Robert Chapuis (L'OURS 2017), Marie Goupy analisa os acontecimentos políticos que marcaram o período entreguerras, particularmente a crise de 1929 e a ascensão do fascismo na Alemanha, bem como as crises do parlamentarismo na França no mesmo período. Ao fazê-lo, não procura encontrar uma analogia com o período atual, mas produzir uma genealogia que nos permita refletir sobre as contradições que a nossa democracia liberal ainda hoje apresenta. Nas palavras de Cédric Moreau de Bellaing (*Droit et Société* 2018), ao não mais apreender a crise como um fenômeno conjuntural, mas como condição sine qua non para o desencadeamento do estado de exceção, e portanto como parte da própria teoria, Marie Goupy lança luz sobre uma contradição interna na obra de Carl Schmitt, longe de romper com a ordem liberal, a teoria do estado de exceção apenas a renovaria, esta oferecendo primeira em momentos de crise os meios concretos para que um governo, qualquer que seja sua forma, perdure. Goupy levanta assim a hipótese de que Carl Schmitt desconhece que a ordem liberal funciona por sucessão de crises e que essa cegueira se deve a um enfoque extremo do jurista alemão no domínio político, deixando de lado o fato de que a ordem liberal promove formas de despolitização em todos os domínios sociais: economia, moralidade, cultura, etc. Ao fazê-lo, não só a teoria da exceção não entra em contradição com a ordem liberal como, ao mesmo tempo, um meio de salvá-la, pois assim que ela passa por uma crise e estruturalmente passa regularmente o estado de exceção oferece-lhe a possibilidade de se perpetuar. Ou, mais exatamente, a teoria da exceção surge como essa noção que solapa as instituições liberais ao identificar sua fragilidade consubstancial e como solução para sua preservação, ao menos na ordem política. Trata-se, portanto, de uma obra de leitura indispensável que enriquecer enormemente o debate público brasileiro.
