The Gate: The True Story of the Design and Construction of the Golden Gate Bridge John van der Zee,2024-03-30 John van der Zee has mastered the technical details of his subject he has used his talents as writer to narrate not only the technical but also the human drama involved in

bringing the concept of a great bridge to fruition Engineering projects necessarily involve a large cast of characters and van der Zee has portrayed his as deftly as a novelist might The engineers in this book come alive as people with all the faults and foibles associated with the human species The story of the Golden Gate Bridge is principally the story of its chief engineer Joseph Strauss and he is both hero and villain of the piece Strauss claimed he could build a bridge for under 25 million and in 1921 produced an ungainly design that was priced at 17 million.
