

Basic Essay Structure

Introduction

- Introduce key background information
- Define key terms
- Indicate previous studies
- Signpost the sequence of your body sections
- Thesis Statement is the last sentence, "This paper will..."

Body

- Only one main idea per paragraph
- ~ 200 words in each paragraph
- First sentence must be a Topic Sentence (paragraph main idea)
- Supporting sentences add more information to support the Topic Sentence
- Include evidence, examples, references to support each claim
