

Find two consecutive integers whose product is 182.

Assign the variable:

$$\begin{array}{ll} \text{1st} = x & -13 \quad \text{or} \quad -14 \\ \text{2nd} = x + 1 & -14 \quad \text{or} \quad -13 \end{array}$$

Answer the question:

The integers are 13 and 14
or -13 and -14.

Write and solve the equation:

$$\begin{array}{ll} x(x+1) = 182 & \text{Translate} \\ x^2 + x = 182 & \text{Get equal to zero} \\ x^2 + x - 182 = 0 & \text{Factor (Guess Numbers)} \\ (x-13)(x+14) = 0 & \text{Solve} \\ x-13 = 0 & \text{or} \quad x+14 = 0 \\ x = 13 & x = -14 \end{array}$$

Plug them in!

13 and -14 aren't consecutive, so you have to plug in each number back in separately. Since both answers work in the context of the problem, you will have two solutions!

Mary and Larry's ages differ by seven years. Larry is the oldest. The product of their ages is 144. Find Mary and Larry's age.

Assign the variable:

$$\begin{array}{ll} \text{Mary} = x - 7 & -9 \\ \text{Larry} = x & -16 \end{array}$$

Answer the question:

Larry is 16 and Mary is 9.

Write and solve the equation:

$$\begin{array}{ll} x(x-7) = 144 & \text{Translate} \\ x^2 - 7x = 144 & \text{Get equal to zero} \\ x^2 - 7x - 144 = 0 & \text{Factor (Guess Numbers)} \\ (x+9)(x-16) = 0 & \text{Solve} \\ x+9 = 0 & \text{or} \quad x-16 = 0 \\ x = -9 & x = 16 \end{array}$$

Plug them in!

Age can't be negative, so cross out -9. Larry must be 16, and then plug 16 into the variable to get Mary's age.
