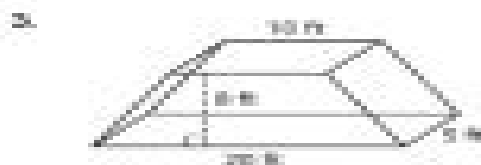
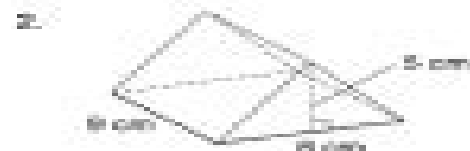

Find the volume of each figure.

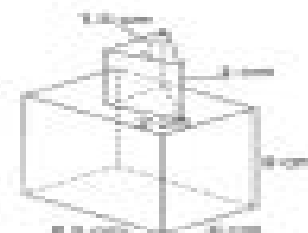


Using cheese, Theo made the display shown at right. Use the figure to complete Exercises 5–7.
