ACUTE KIDNEY INJURY (AKI)

Acute Kidney Injury (AKI)

AKI is a sudden decline in kidney function, leading to a buildup of waste products in the blood. It is a common complication in critically ill patients and can be life-threatening if not treated promptly.

Causes:

- Low blood flow to the kidneys (hypotension)
- Medications (e.g., antibiotics, painkillers)
- Infections
- Obstruction of the urinary tract

Diagnosis:

AKI is diagnosed based on an increase in serum creatinine and a decrease in urine output.

Management:

- Identify and treat the underlying cause.
- Fluid management: Maintain adequate hydration.
- Dialysis: May be required in severe cases.

CRUST PNEUM

CRUST PNEUM is a condition characterized by a thick, crusty layer of mucus in the lungs, leading to impaired gas exchange and respiratory distress.

Causes:

- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)
- Asthma
- Smoking

Diagnosis:

CRUST PNEUM is diagnosed through a combination of physical examination, chest X-ray, and sputum analysis.

Management:

- Inhalers and steroids to reduce inflammation.
- Physical therapy and breathing exercises.
- Antibiotics if a bacterial infection is present.

ASTHMA

ASTHMA

ASTHMA is a chronic inflammatory condition of the airways, leading to bronchoconstriction and wheezing. It is a common respiratory condition that can be managed with medication and lifestyle changes.

Causes:

- Genetics
- Allergies
- Environmental factors (e.g., pollution, smoke)

Diagnosis:

ASTHMA is diagnosed based on a history of symptoms, physical examination, and pulmonary function tests.

Management:

- Inhalers (bronchodilators and corticosteroids).
- Avoidance of triggers.

Causes:

- Coronary artery disease
- Heart failure
- Medications

Diagnosis:

HEART BLOCK is diagnosed through an electrocardiogram (ECG) and other diagnostic tests.

Management:

- Medications to regulate heart rhythm.
- Implantation of a pacemaker.
