The Mammoth Book of Air Disasters and Near Misses Paul Simpson, 2014-10-16 An incredible 30 000 flights at least arrive safely at their destinations every day But a handful don't while some come terrifyingly close to crashing When even the smallest thing does go wrong at 35 000 feet the result is nearly always a fast unfolding tragedy This extensive collection of compelling real life accounts of air disasters and near disasters provides a sobering alternative history of the just over 105 years that passengers have been travelling by air from the very earliest fatality to recent calamities But there are incredible stories of heroism against the odds too such as that of Captain Chesley Sullenberger who successfully landed his aircraft with both engines gone on the Hudson River in New York saving the lives of everyone aboard and of the American Airlines crew who prevented terrorist Richard Reid from exploding a bomb hidden in his shoe three months after 9 11 The book also details the often ingenious always painstaking work done by air accident investigators while a glossary helps to clarify the occasional inevitable bits of jargon

The Mammoth Book of Superstition Roy Bainton,2016-11-10 Rather than providing a dictionary of superstitions of which there are already numerous excellent exhaustive and in many cases academic works which list superstitions from A to Z Bainton gives us an entertaining flight over the terrain landing from time to time in more thought provoking areas He offers an overview of humanity s often illogical and irrational persistence in seeking good luck and avoiding misfortune While Steve Roud s two excellent books The Penguin Dictionary of Superstitions and his Pocket Guide and Philippa Waring s 1970 Dictionary concentrate on the British Isles Bainton casts his net much wider There are many origins which warrant the full back story such as Friday the thirteenth and the Knights Templar or the demonisation of the domestic cat resulting in cat holocausts throughout Europe led by the Popes and the Inquisition The whole is presented as a comprehensive entertaining narrative flow though it is of course a book that could be dipped into and includes a thorough bibliography Schoenberg who developed the twelve tone technique in music was a notorious triskaidekaphobe When the title of his opera Moses und Aaron resulted in a title with thirteen letters he renamed it Moses und Aron He believed he would die in his seventy sixth year 7 6 13 and he was correct he also died on Friday the thirteenth at thirteen minutes before midnight As Sigmund Freud wrote Superstition is in large part the expectation of trouble and a person who has harboured frequent evil wishes against others but has been brought up to be good and has therefore repressed such wishes into the unconscious will be especially ready to expect punishment for his unconscious wickedness in the form of trouble threatening him from without

chicanery of some forensic scientists over zealous or negligent police officers under pressure to get results incompetent lawyers lying witnesses bribed juries judicial blunders and feeble politicians Sometimes however it is truculent and uncooperative defendants who prove their own worst enemies It shows the mistakes that can be made in the face of a baying public and a rabid press mistakes which have seen innocent men and women found guilty and sometimes executed while others have served lengthy sentences It reveals critical flaws in criminal justice systems throughout the world it is estimated for example that two per cent of felony cases in America result in wrongful convictions Morton explores folk devils and moral panics both historical such as the witches of Salem and and much more recent cases like that of the West Memphis Three It considers cases of race hatred the impact of DNA fit ups fake experts doubtful science and the long road to the court of appeal He also looks at what happens to the victims of miscarriages of justice whether they go on to prosper or as is sadly so often the case never really recover How did the boxer Rubin The Hurricane Carter come to be wrongly convicted of a triple homicide The alibi of Joe Hill the Industrial Workers of the World activist wrongly executed for the murder of a Utah grocer and his son came too late to save him from execution On the other hand Lindy Chamberlain famously portrayed by Meryl Streep in *A Cry in the Dark* has finally over thirty years after the fact had her claim that her baby Azaria was taken by a dingo at Ayers Rock in the Australian Outback upheld by a coroner Among many other cases Morton also considers the 1910 case of two men convicted of the murder of a man still alive in 1926 and case of the West Memphis Three who were convicted as teenagers in 1994 of the murders of three boys in Arkansas and released in 2011 in a plea bargain after eighteen years though the prosecution still refuses to accept their innocence

Voices From the Napoleonic Wars Jon E. Lewis, 2015-04-09

Voices from the Napoleonic Wars reveals in telling detail the harsh lives of soldiers at the turn of the eighteenth century and in the early years of the nineteenth the poor food and brutal discipline they endured along with the forced marches and bloody hand to hand combat Contemporaries were mesmerised by Napoleon and with good reason in 1812 he had an unprecedented million men and more under arms His new model army of volunteers and conscripts at epic battles such as Austerlitz Salamanca Borodino Jena and of course Waterloo marked the beginning of modern warfare the road to the Sommes and Stalingrad The citizen in arms of Napoleon's Grande Armée and other armies of the time gave rise to a distinct body of soldiers personal memoirs The personal accounts that Jon E Lewis has selected from these memoirs as well as from letters and diaries include those of Rifleman Harris fighting in the Peninsular Wars and Captain Alexander Cavalie Mercer of the Royal Horse Artillery at Waterloo They cover the land campaigns of the French Revolutionary Wars 1793 1802 the Napoleonic Wars 1803 1815 and the War of 1812 1812 1815 in North America This was the age of cavalry charges of horse drawn artillery of muskets and hand to hand combat with sabres and bayonets It was an era in which inspirational leadership and patriotic common cause counted for much at close quarters on chaotic and bloody battlefields The men who wrote these accounts were directly involved in the sweeping campaigns and climactic battles that set Europe and America alight at the

turn of the eighteenth century and in the years that followed. Alongside recollections of the ferocity of hard fought battles are the equally telling details of the common soldier's daily life: short rations, forced marches in the searing heat of the Iberian summer and the bitter cold of the Russian winter, debilitating illnesses and crippling wounds, looting and the lash, but also the compensations of hard won comradeship in the face of ever present death. Collectively these personal accounts give us the most vivid picture of warfare 200 and more years ago in the evocative language of those who knew it at first hand: the men and officers of the British, French and American armies. They let us know exactly what it was like to be an infantryman, a cavalryman, an artilleryman of the time.

The Serial Killer Files Paul Simpson, 2017-05-18 There are many myths about serial killers: that they are all dysfunctional loners, all white males, only motivated by sex, that they all travel and operate across a wide area, cannot stop killing, are all insane or evil geniuses, and that they all want to get caught. Of course, there are some serial killers who fit into these categories, but the married Green River Killer was not a dysfunctional loner; there are plenty of female and non-Caucasian serial killers. Dr. Harold Shipman was certainly not motivated by sex; many serial killings, such as the Ipswich prostitute murders carried out by Steve Wright, happen within a confined area; the BTK Killer, Dennis Rader, stopped killing in 1991 but wasn't caught until fourteen years later. Many serial killers may have a low animal cunning or be street smart, but few of them are Mensa level geniuses. Each of the thirty cases covered here is unusual in some respect, perhaps in the way in which the killer carried out their crimes, the choice of victims, the way in which they were apprehended, or the method of their execution. The cases are presented alphabetically by country, from Australia via Colombia, Great Britain, Indonesia, Iran, South Africa, and elsewhere, to the United States, and then chronologically. They come from across history and from all over the world. The author has gone back as far as possible to contemporary source material, newspaper accounts, trial evidence.

Normal Accidents Charles Perrow, 2011-10-12 Normal Accidents analyzes the social side of technological risk Charles Perrow argues that the conventional engineering approach to ensuring safety building in more warnings and safeguards fails because systems complexity makes failures inevitable He asserts that typical precautions by adding to complexity may help create new categories of accidents At Chernobyl tests of a new safety system helped produce the meltdown and subsequent fire By recognizing two dimensions of risk complex versus linear interactions and tight versus loose coupling this book provides a powerful framework for analyzing risks and the organizations that insist we run them The first edition fulfilled one reviewer's prediction that it may mark the beginning of accident research In the new afterword to this edition Perrow reviews the extensive work on the major accidents of the last fifteen years including Bhopal Chernobyl and the Challenger disaster The new postscript probes what the author considers to be the quintessential Normal Accident of our time the Y2K computer problem
