Fine, 2012-04-26 In Jewish Integration in the German Army in the First World War David J Fine offers a surprising portrayal of Jewish officers in the German army as integrated and comfortably identified as both Jews and Germans Fine explores how both Judaism and Christianity were experienced by Jewish soldiers at the front making an important contribution to the study of the experience of religion in war Fine shows how the encounter of German Jewish soldiers with the old world of the shtetl on the eastern front tested both their German and Jewish identities Finally utilizing published and unpublished sources including letters diaries memoirs military service records press accounts photographs drawings and tomb stone inscriptions the author argues that antisemitism was not a primary factor in the war experience of Jewish soldiers

Hitler's Jewish Soldiers Bryan Mark Rigg, 2002 On the murderous road to racial purity Hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding Jewish identity After centuries of Jewish assimilation and intermarriage in German society he discovered that eliminating Jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he'd anticipated As Bryan Rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the German military Contrary to conventional views Rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of German military men were classified by the Nazis as Jews or partial Jews Mischlinge in the wake of racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s Rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals As Rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves Jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots

had before Nazi Germany was eventually defeated in May 1945. Equally important however and one of the characteristics of this book is the analysis of the meaning and value of Nazi material culture over time. The interpreters of Nazi symbols that this book focuses on are internationally based private collectors and traders. Sustained attention is given in a chapter outlining the development of the collectors market for Nazi memorabilia from 1945 onwards. No matter how much collectors go out of their way to paint the hobby in a positive light their activities do not fully escape the troubled past of the material that they desire. So contested are Nazi symbols that another chapter is devoted to the ethics and morals of destroying or preserving them. The issues surrounding private versus public custody and ownership of Nazi artefacts are also discussed. So far in this book the examination of Nazi artefacts has been restricted to physical objects within societies that are generally aware of the consequences of Hitlerism. As we increasingly move into the digital age however and there are few survivors of the Second World War left to relay their horrific experiences the final chapter contemplates the future of Nazi symbols both digitally and physically fake or real. This book will appeal to all those interested in the Third Reich, Nazi ideology, Neo Nazism, perceptions of the Nazis post 1945, modern European history and political symbolism. It will also hold particular appeal to those interested in the collecting and trading of contested and highly emotive artefacts. It considers aesthetics, authenticity, commodification, gift exchange, life histories of people and objects, materiality and value theory.

Corporal Hitler and the Great War 1914-1918 John F Williams, 2005-07-05. Adolf Hitler enlisted in the Bavarian Army in August 1914 as a war volunteer. Fanatically devoted to the German cause between 1914 and 1918, Hitler served with distinction and sometimes reckless bravery, winning both classes of Iron Cross. Using memoirs, military records, regimental divisional and official war histories, as well as wherever possible Hitler's own words, this book seeks to reconstruct a period in his life that has been neglected in the literature. It is also the story of a German regiment, the 16th Bavarian Reserve Infantry or List Regiment, which fought in all the main battles on the Western Front. As a frontline soldier, Hitler began his study of the black art of propaganda and as he himself maintained, the List Regiment provided him with his university of life. This is not only an account of the fighting, however. Some of the most profound influences on Hitler occurred on home leave or as a result of official wartime propaganda which he devoured uncritically. His conversion from passive pathological anti-Semitism began while invalided in Germany in 1916-17. The language of anti-Bolshevik Jewish virus propaganda became Hitler's language confirmed as he saw it by the infected recruits to the List Regiment in 1918. Hitler is here presented less as the product of high cultural forces than as an avid reader and gullible consumer of state propaganda which fed his prejudices. He was a good soldier but also a true believer in fact and practice. It is no exaggeration to say that every military decision made by Hitler between 1939 and 1945 was in some way influenced or coloured by his experiences with the List Regiment between 1914 and 1918.

at the periphery of Germany's warfare but were in fact heavily involved. What none could have foreseen was the dangerous legacy they created together: a legacy that enabled Hitler's rise to power and planted the seeds of the Holocaust to come. Comrades Betrayed Michael Geheran, 2020-10-15. At the end of 1941, six weeks after the mass deportations of Jews from Nazi Germany had begun, Gestapo offices across the Reich received an urgent telex from Adolf Eichmann decreeing that all war-wounded and decorated Jewish veterans of World War I be exempted from upcoming evacuations. Why this was so and how Jewish veterans at least initially were able to avoid the fate of ordinary Jews under the Nazis is the subject of Comrades Betrayed. Michael Geheran deftly illuminates how the same values that compelled Jewish soldiers to demonstrate bravery in the front lines in World War I made it impossible for them to accept passively, let alone comprehend, persecution under Hitler. After all, they upheld the ideal of the German fighting man: embraced the fatherland and cherished the bonds that had developed in military service. Through their diaries and private letters, as well as interviews with eyewitnesses and surviving family members and records from the police, Gestapo, and military, Michael Geheran presents a major challenge to the prevailing view that Jewish veterans were left isolated, neighborless, and having suffered a social death by 1938. Tracing the path from the trenches of the Great War to the extermination camps of the Third Reich, Geheran exposes a painful dichotomy: while many Jewish former combatants believed that Germany would never betray them, the Holocaust was nonetheless a horrific reality. In chronicling Jewish veterans' appeal to older traditional notions of comradeship and national belonging, Comrades Betrayed forces reflection on how this group made use of scant opportunities to defy Nazi persecution and for some to evade becoming victims of the Final Solution.
