C.: A Walk through the Times Literary Supplement* James Campbell, 2023-05-02 NB by J C a collection of James Campbell's best columns from the TLS is a guide to the literary pleasures and absurdities of the past two decades For over twenty years James Campbell wrote the popular NB column on the back page of *The Times Literary Supplement* signing it J C The initials were not intended as a disguise but to provide freedom to the persona J C was irreverent whimsical occasionally severe The column had a low tolerance for the literary sins of pomposity hypocrisy and cant It took aim at contemporary absurdities resulting from identity politics or from academic jargon Readers of NB by J C will find not only an off beat guide to our cultural times but entries from *The TLS Reviewer's Handbook* which offered regular advice on the cultivation of a good writing style Above all aspire to the Three E's elegance eloquence and entertainment The Introduction offers a history of the TLS from its beginnings through its precarious stages of adaptation and survival The secret of J C's weekly column is its unique mix of anonymity with intimacy this stranger whom we meet over our morning coffee is the most discreet and delightful of guides to what's happening good or mostly bad in the literary world with all its pretensions follies and occasional triumphs I especially relished J C's prizes for the worst prose or the silliest blurb Then again leave it to J C to find the rare edition the forgotten book of poems that deserves another look True wit coupled with wisdom it's the rarest of writerly feats Marjorie Perloff author of *The Vienna Paradox A Memoir* I receive immense pleasure from J C's columns Something more than pleasure warmth laughter gratitude especially when he is nailing academic unreadability Vivian Gornick author of *Unfinished Business Notes of a Chronic Re Reader* For many years Campbell appeared each week in the *Times Literary Supplement* where his back page essay ironic bookish and irresistibly entertaining was every subscriber's favorite feature Michael Dirda *Washington Post* on James Campbell's NB column **Monsters In The Woods** Tim Hauserman, 2007-03-08 How and why you should take your children backpacking Despite America's enthusiasm for outdoors activities like hiking and backpacking most books on these subjects focus on adults Backpacking however is an ideal activity for the entire family Tim Hauserman who is both an experienced outdoors guide and the father of two daughters now offers a handbook for parents who would

and deeds directly or indirectly touches the lives of others If that touch is positive its multiplier impact on the society would be enduring and he has humbly tried that Many of the articles included in the book were published earlier in newspapers and magazines but have since been revised and updated While endorsing civic law awareness the author prescribes raising the bar of cost for violators of law He suggests intervention for the needy and seeks support for causes that would bring about a Change Essays have a wide angle including discussion on civil services governance integrity work ethics lack of nationalistic fervor ills of unplanned urbanization missing attention to civic responsibility and non adherence to civic laws etc But witty interludes are not neglected either which add flavor to the book Added to that is the authors selective reliance on Urdu and Hindi citations along with transliteration sharpening the message The incisive critical appraisals have been followed by suggested remedial action through citizen involvement This ensures that readers are not left in the limbo about what next
