Leaf Size: 2.5 cm to 7.5 cm Water Conservation Strategy: Leaves die back in dry conditions

Black Mustard Non-Native Plant

Scientific Name: Brassica Nigra

Description: A tall branching plant with bright green broad leaves and small bright yellow flowers. Sprouts in early spring and often dies by late spring.

Leaf Size: up to 25 cm

Water Conservation Strategy:

Lives its whole life cycle in one rainy season.

Lemonade Berry Native Plant

Scientific Name: Rhus integrifolia

Description: An evergreen shrub with rounded dull green leaves with a waxy coating. In spring they produce small, light pink flowers. In the summer they produce small reddish berries.

Leaf Size: 5 cm to 7 cm

Water Conservation Strategy: Leaves have a thick waxy coating to prevent water loss

California Sagebrush Native Plant

Scientific Name: Artemesia californica

Description: A medium sized shrub with light silverygreen leaves. The leaves are separated into several narrow needle like leaves. The leaves have small hairs that make them soft to the touch.

LeafSize: Icmto6cm

Water Conservation Strategy: Leaves die back in dry conditions
