The book draws on a theoretical framework of capabilities asset-based community development and the adult learning concept of dialogue to propose a model whereby the boundary walls of the university become metaphorically porous so that community members feel free to interact with the university as equal members of society. A historical outline of African universities is provided as well as an exploration of the evolution of terms for community engagement, service learning and learning cities and an examination of the policy and practice implications for the ideological model of a porous university.
