Aldo Di Giovanni **The Enduring Covenant** Padraic O'Hare, 1997-01-01. The idea for this book arose out of the author's fifteen years of sustained engagement in Jewish-Christian relations. His purpose here is to speak about the practice of religious education in the church in which anti-Judaism is eliminated. O'Hare focuses on the holiness of the religious community which he notes can develop along triumphal, absolute and exclusive lines. He suggests instead that every time we unearth a defensive and xenophobic practice or pattern of speech in our religion and set it aside we are doing something that adds to the health of our religious community to its capacity to assist people to become holy. Chapter 1 surveys what philosopher Jules Isaac calls the history of the teaching of contempt; chapter 2 deals with genuine religious pluralism and dialogue; chapter 3 is a short Christology devoid of triumphalism and exclusivism; chapter 4 focuses on religious education and its purpose to form holy people; chapter 5 is an appreciation of the genius of Judaism, its world view and life; chapter 6 focuses on practice including elements of a paradigm shift in religious education principles for such practice and select examples of programs of religious education for interreligious reverence especially between Jews and Christians. Padraic O'Hare teaches in the Religious Studies Department of Merrimack College, North Andover, MA and is the author of *The Way of Faithfulness: Contemplation and Formation in the Church*, also published by Trinity Press.

The Abased Christ Thomas J. Millay, 2022-10-03. *The Abased Christ* is the first monograph to be devoted exclusively to Søren Kierkegaard's Christological masterpiece *Practice in Christianity*. Alongside an argument for a new translation of the work's title it offers

detailed textual commentary on a series of themes in Practice in Christianity such as the person of Christ contemporaneity imitation and Kierkegaard's philosophy of history Anti Climacus the pseudonymous author of Practice in Christianity presents to his readers a uniquely challenging understanding of who Christ is and what it means to follow him The Christ of Anti Climacus is not the glorious Christ who abides with the Father in heaven but the abased Christ who is poor marginal offensive and persecuted Throughout Practice in Christianity we are called not only to perceive the abased Christ but to follow after him The Abased Christ aims to enrich historical theologians appreciation of Kierkegaard's Christology However it concludes by grappling with questions of power agency and sacrifice which have been at the forefront of contemporary theology in the 20th and 21st centuries thereby suggesting how we might make sense of Kierkegaard's Christology today

Ecology in Jurgen Moltmann's Theology Celia E. Deane-Drummond, 2016-09-01 This book offers a critical and constructive analysis of the contribution of Jurgen Moltmann to the field of ecotheology Moltmann is one of the foremost and influential contemporary theologians of our time but his specific contribution to ecotheology has received relatively scant attention in the secondary literature The author deals sensitively with the relevant scientific aspects necessary in order to develop an adequate theology of the natural world She also offers a careful and constructive analysis of the specific systematic theologies of creation humanity eschatology and Trinity that are woven into Moltmann's rich interpretation of the relationship between God and creation

DeJonge, 2012-02-24 Dietrich Bonhoeffer's dramatic biography a son of privilege who suffered imprisonment and execution after involving himself in a conspiracy to kill Hitler and overthrow the Third Reich has helped make him one of the most influential Christian figures of the twentieth century But before he was known as a martyr or a hero he was a student and teacher of theology This book examines the academic formation of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's theology arguing that the young Bonhoeffer reinterpreted for a modern intellectual context the Lutheran understanding of the person of Jesus Christ In the process Bonhoeffer not only distinguished himself from both Karl Barth and Karl Holl whose dialectical theology and Luther interpretation respectively were two of the most important post World War I theological movements but also established the basic character of his own person theology Barth convinces Bonhoeffer that theology must understand revelation as originating outside the human self in God's freedom But whereas Barth understands revelation as the act of an eternal divine subject Bonhoeffer treats revelation as the act and being of the historical person of Jesus Christ On the basis of this person concept of revelation Bonhoeffer rejects Barth's dialectical thought designed to respect the distinction between God and world for a hermeneutical way of thinking that begins with the reconciliation of God and world in the person of Christ Here Bonhoeffer mines a

Lutheran understanding of the incarnation as God's unreserved entry into history and the person of Christ as the resulting historical reconciliation of opposites. This also distinguishes Bonhoeffer's Lutheranism from that of Karl Holl, one of Bonhoeffer's teachers in Berlin, whose location of justification in the conscience renders the presence of Christ superfluous. Against this, Bonhoeffer emphasizes the present person of Christ as the precondition of justification. Through these critical conversations, Bonhoeffer develops the features of his person theology: a person concept of revelation and a hermeneutical way of thinking which remain constant despite the sometimes radical changes in his thought.

The Spirit of Polyphony Joanna Tarassenko, 2024-01-25 This book re-examines how Bonhoeffer employs musical patterns of thought and language to a theological end. It outlines how the significance of Bonhoeffer's musical theology has not been sufficiently recognised and sets the stage for a rigorous re-examination. It becomes clear that through the lens of his musical metaphor of polyphony, Bonhoeffer demonstrates how his account of Christian formation contains a latent pneumatology. Tarassenko demonstrates that incorporation of this pneumatology is key in deepening one's understanding of Bonhoeffer. It allows the relationship between Christology and Christian formation in Bonhoeffer's thought to become fully realised. The appeal to polyphony articulates this pneumatology as an indirect but nevertheless exceedingly successful means of contouring an account of the Spirit's work.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer's Christian Humanism Jens Zimmermann, 2019-06-13 Jens Zimmermann locates Bonhoeffer within the Christian humanist tradition extending back to patristic theology. He begins by explaining Bonhoeffer's own use of the term humanism and Christian humanism and considering how his criticism of liberal Protestant theology prevents him from articulating his own theology rhetorically as a Christian humanism. He then provides an in-depth portrayal of Bonhoeffer's theological anthropology and establishes that Bonhoeffer's Christology and attendant anthropology closely resemble patristic teaching. The volume also considers Bonhoeffer's mature anthropology, focusing in particular on the Christian self.
