ignore this copper

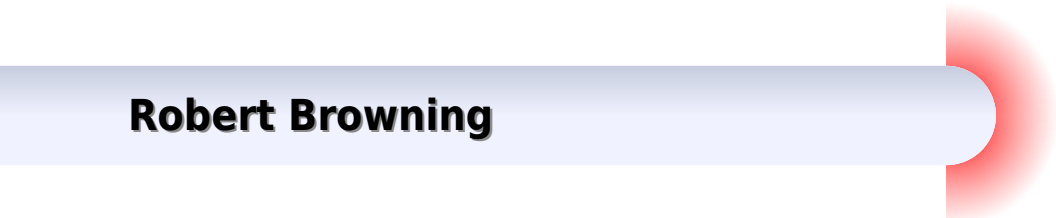
and I pick up a stick
