Tschudy,2014 New Glarus was founded in 1845 by impoverished citizens of Glarus Switzerland Much of Europe was in the grips of a severe depression food was in short supply and jobs were equally scarce In response to this crisis the Swiss government formed the Swiss Emigration Society The society offered passage to America for anyone who wanted to leave Switzerland On April 16 1845 a ship took 193 Swiss to the United States Four months later on August 16 these pioneers arrived in what would become New Glarus The founding of this community might be one of the finest examples of the best of socialism Each settler received 20 acres of land drawn through a lottery land could not be exchanged for something better The oxen teams needed to work the land were communally owned The settlers looked out for the welfare of all providing schooling food shelter and health care
