#### **Fundamentals**

#### Creating a Table

CREATE TABLE cities ( city VARCHAR(30) NOT NULL, state VARCHAR(30) NOT NULL, population INT );

The CREATE TABLE cities

statement creates and names a table within a database.

Within the parentheses, the data to be inserted is specified. Similar to headers in an Excel spreadsheet, city, state, and population define this data.

#### Inserting Values

INSERT INTO cities (city, state, population) VALUES ('Alameda', 'California', 79177);

The INSERT INTO statement first specifies the table and columns, then the VALUES line inserts the corresponding data.

#### Viewing the Table

Tables are easily viewed by using the SELECT statement.

SELECT \* FROM cities;

The \* signifies selecting all available data, while FROM indicates the specific table to view.

Symtax note: the use of a semicolon signifies the completion of a code set, called a statement terminator. While most interpreters are smart enough to work without one, not all will and it is best practice to end a SQL statement in this manner.

#### Queries

Queries retrieve specific data from within a table. The query can be customized to be as broad or specific as the user wishes with the use of conditional operators.

// Return rows with a specific
value in column\_a
SELECT =
FROM table\_1
WHERE column\_a = 'value';

#### WHERE and AND:

// Include multiple values with the AND operator SELECT = FROM table\_1 MMERE column\_a = 'value' AND column\_b = 'value';

#### WHERE and OR:

// Return data containing
either one value or another
using the OR operator
SELECT =
FROM table\_1
wHERE column\_a = "value"
OR column\_b = 'value';

#### WHERE and IN:

// Return data containing
multiple values in a column
using the IN operator
SELECT \*
FROM table\_1
MMERE column\_a IN ('value\_a',
'value\_b');

#### WHERE NOT:

// Exclude certain data with
the WHERE NOT operators
SELECT =
FROM table\_1
WHERE NOT column\_a = 'value';

#### WHERE and NOT IN:

// Exclude certain values from
a query using the NOT IN
operators
SELECT =
FROM table\_1
WHERE column\_a NOT IN
('value\_a', 'value\_b');

#### Joins

Data combined from different sets of data, or tables, is referred to as a join. Joins are completed using a column that is common between tables.

LEFT JOIN: returns all records from the left table and the matched records from the right table.

SELECT column(s) FROM table\_1 LEFT JOIN table\_2 ON table\_1.column\_name = table\_2.column\_name;

RIGHT JOIN: returns all records from the right table, and the matched records from the left table.

SELECT column(s) FROM table\_1 RIGHT JOIN table\_2 ON table\_1.column\_name = table\_2.column\_name;

INVER JOIN: returns records that have matching values in both tables.

SELECT column(s) FROM table\_1 INNER JOIN table\_2 ON table\_1.column\_name = table\_2.column\_name;

CROSS JOIN: returns records that match every row of the left table with every row of the right table. This type of join has the potential to make very large tables. Note that there are no additional conditions to be met to join the data.

SELECT column(s) FROM table\_1 CROSS JOIN table\_2;

FULL OUTER JOIN: after an inner join is performed, null values are placed within the columns that do not match between the two tables. Note that the OUTER keyword is optional when using this join.

SELECT column(s) FROM table\_1 FULL OUTER JOIN table\_b ON table\_1.column\_name = table\_2.column\_name;
