Spurgeon, Volume 58** Spurgeon, Charles H., Volume 58 Sermons 3283 3334 Charles Spurgeon 19 June 1834 31 January 1892 is one of the church's most famous preachers and Christianity's foremost prolific writers Called the Prince of Preachers he was one of England's most notable ministers for most of the second half of the nineteenth century and he still remains highly influential among Christians of different denominations today His sermons have spread all over the world and his many printed works have been cherished classics for decades In his lifetime Spurgeon preached to more than 10 million people often up to ten times each week He was the pastor of the congregation of the New Park Street Chapel later the Metropolitan Tabernacle in London for 38 years He was an inexhaustible author of various kinds of works including sermons commentaries an autobiography as well as books on
