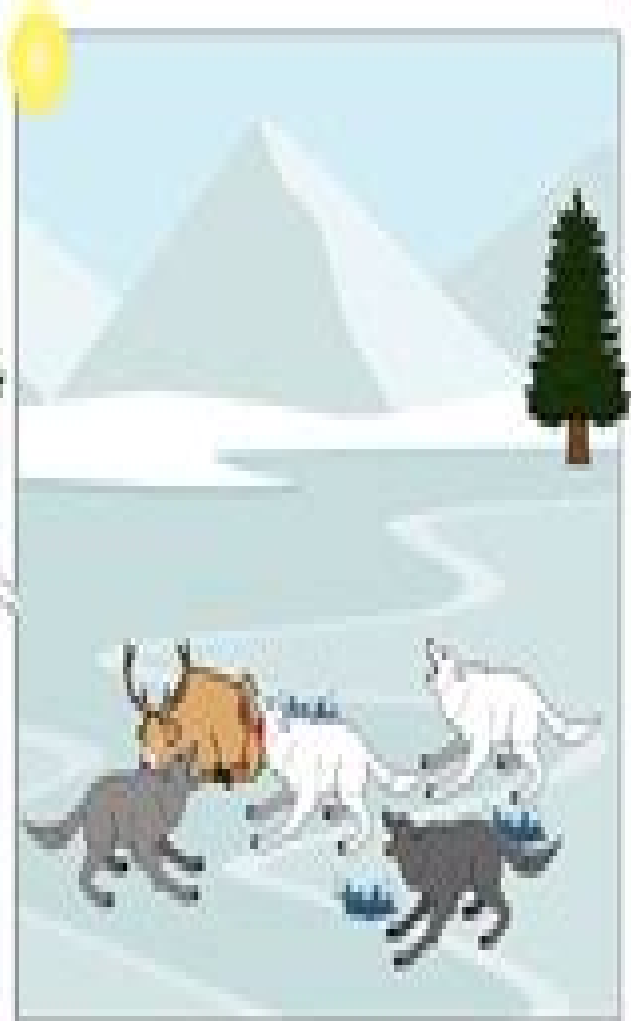

interviews to document this gendered compulsory birth control a phenomenon in which people who give birth are held accountable for preventing and resolving pregnancies in gender constrained ways She shows how this gendered approach encroaches on reproductive autonomy and poses obstacles for preventing disease While diverse cisgender women are the focus Littlejohn shows that they are not the only ones harmed by this dynamic Indeed gendered approaches to birth control also negatively impact trans intersex and gender nonconforming people in overlooked ways In tracing the divisive politics of pregnancy prevention Littlejohn demonstrates that the gendered division of labor in birth control is not natural It is unjust
