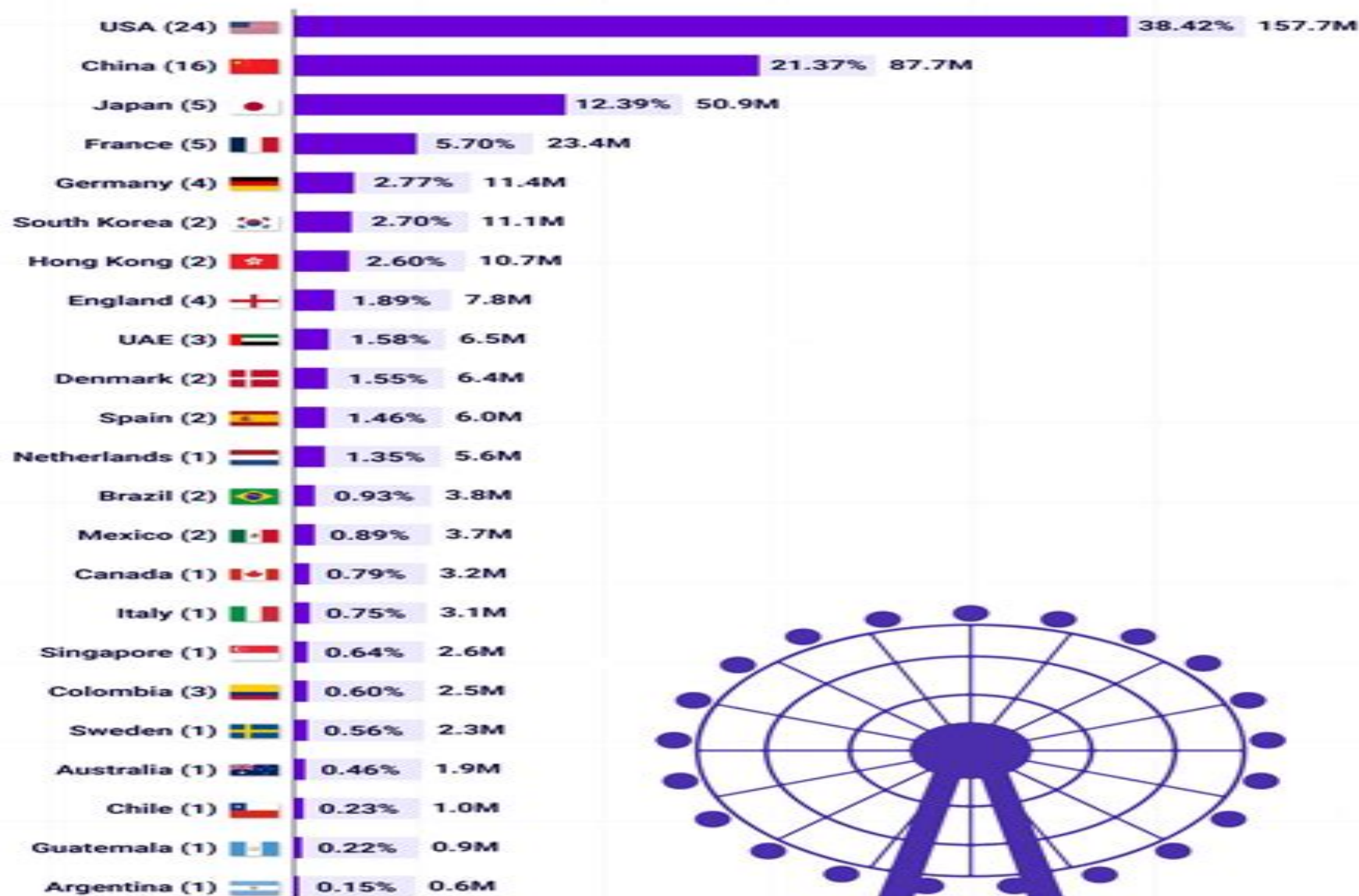


Countries With the Highest Theme Park Attendance
