Balances

$$I + G = O + D + S$$

Mass Balance

For steady systems (no storage):

$$m_{in} = m_{out}$$

For systems with stored mass:

$$m_{in} = m_{out} + (m_{final} - m_{initial})$$

Mass rate

$$\dot{m}_{in} = \dot{m}_{out} + \frac{dM_{sys}}{dt}$$

Generally, we can neglect the storage term for these cases, but it is dependent on the system.

Energy Balance:

The following are for systems where we can neglect kinetic and potential energy (most cases, refer to the reference packet):

For systems without stored mass but that still have mass flowing in or out of the system:

$$Q_{in} + W_{in} + m_{in}h_{in} = Q_{out} + W_{out} + m_{out}h_{out}$$

For systems that have a stored mass but no mass flowing in or out

$$Q_{in} + W_{in} = Q_{out} + W_{out} + (m_{final}u_{final} - m_{initial}u_{initial})$$

For systems with both:

$$Q_{in} + W_{in} + m_{in}h_{in} = Q_{out} + W_{out} + m_{out}h_{out} + (m_{final}u_{final} - m_{initial}u_{initial})$$

General Energy Balance:

$$Q_{in} + W_{in} + m_{in} \left(h_{in} + \frac{v_{in}^2}{2} + gz_1 \right) = Q_{out} + W_{out} + m_{out} \left(h_{out} + \frac{v_{out}^2}{2} + gz_2 \right) + (\Delta U + \Delta KE + \Delta PE)$$

For the energy storage term, decide which one fits the problem the best.

Energy rate balance

$$\dot{Q}_{in} + \dot{W}_{in} + \dot{m}_{in} \left(h_{in} + \frac{v_{in}^2}{2} + gz_1 \right) = \dot{Q}_{out} + \dot{W}_{out} + \dot{m}_{out} \left(h_{out} + \frac{v_{out}^2}{2} + gz_2 \right)$$

Entropy Balance:

If there is mass flowing into or out of the system:

$$\frac{Q_1}{T_{b1}} + m_{in}s_{in} + S_{gen} = \frac{Q_2}{T_{b2}} + m_{out}s_{out}$$
