These Demented Lands Alan Warner, 1997 An aircraft investigator gathers fallen pieces of planes and a young woman arrives at the Drome Hotel strangely familiar A rave is organised for twisted characters The Argonaut The Knife Sharpener and The Devil's Advocate converge for one last Saturday night at the Drome Hotel **These DeMented Lands** Alan Warner, 1998-02 After the critical success of his first novel *Morvern Callar* Alan Warner has written an extraordinary stirring sequel to *Morvern's* odyssey confirming him as one of the most original uniquely gifted writers to have appeared this decade An air crash investigator haunts the hinterlands of an island around the isolated honeymoon hot spot the Drome Hotel gathering the debris from fallen planes that the islanders have fashioned into makeshift sheds and fences but what kind of jigsaw is he really assembling as he paces the runway A young woman makes landfall on the island crossing the interior to arrive at the Drome Hotel desperate strange and strangely familiar Meanwhile DJ Cormorant is trying to organize The Big One a rave on the adjacent airstrip and from all over *These Demented Lands* come twisted characters converging for one final Saturday night at the Drome Hotel *"These Demented Lands", "Morvern Callar"* Alan Warner, 1998-02-28 Dance, Drugs and Escape Stan Beeler, 2007-06-05 In the late 1980s the rave phenomenon swept the youth culture of the United Kingdom incorporating the generations two newest social stimulants modern electronic dance music and a notorious designer drug known as Ecstasy Although the movement began in rebellion against mainstream culture its underground dynamism soon attracted the interest of novelists screenwriters and filmmakers who attempted to reflect the phenomenon in their works Through artistic and commercial popularization the once obscure subculture was transformed into a pop culture behemoth with powerful links to the entertainment industry This study deals with the transformative effects of film television and literature on club culture Chapters furthermore reflect club culture's own effect on crime ethnicity sexuality and drug use As the study traces artistic depictions of club culture's development each chapter focuses on individual books films and television shows that reflect the transformation of the club culture into what it is today Rewriting Scotland Cristie L. experience but rather upon abstractions of probability or reasonable likelihood Yet even as these changes were occurring the Scottish Highlands and Hebridean Islands were attracting increased attention as a region where witness experience in sublime and communal forms had managed to trump enlightened progress and the probabilistic abstract and mediated mentality on which the Enlightenment was predicated There in a remote corner of Britain natives and tourists beheld things that surpassed enlightened understanding experience was becoming all the more alluring to the extent that it signified something other than knowledge Matthew Wickman examines this uncanny return of experiential authority at the very moment of its supposed decline and traces the alluring improbability of experience into our own time Thematic in its focus and cross disciplinary in its approach *The Ruins of Experience* situates the literary next to the nonliterary the old beside the new Wickman looks to poems novels philosophical texts travel narratives contemporary theory and evidential treatises and trial narratives to suggest an alternative historical view of the paradoxical tensions of the Enlightenment and Romantic eras
