4.1.1 socialization and the sociological perspective

Socialization- the process by which individuals learn the appropriate attitudes and behaviors within a culture

Nature- when you're born with your personhood intact

Nurture- interaction between people

Social Facts: patterns that are external to individuals and greatly influence our way of thinking and behaving in the society

4.1.2 Theories of the self-Mead

"I"- the unsocialized or acting self-made up of personal desires and needs

"Me"- the self-made social up of internalized attitudes of others

Preparatory self-imitation of others

Play stage- pretending to be other people

Significant others- individuals who are essential to the development of self

Game stage- taking the role of multiple people at one time

Generalized other- the process of internalizing societal norms and expectations

Reference group- a collection of people used for comparison and identification

Culture Capital- Pierre Bourdieu, is the cultural resources that people use to their advantage in various situations (passed down through social class via family)

Social interaction- the interpersonal relationship between two or more persons

Social context- the environment of the interaction

Social construction of reality- an individual's perception of one's social world as determined or influenced by social interaction

Social attribution- this is an explanation of how others appear, behave, or are motivated

Fundamental attribution error- the bias of attributing our behaviors to our circumstances and the behavior of others to their character
