Morgan, 2022-08-02 Traces the history of the study of tumor viruses and its role in driving breakthroughs in cancer research Worldwide approximately one fifth of human cancers are caused by tumor viruses with hepatitis B virus and HPV being the leading culprits While the explosive growth in molecular biology in the late twentieth century is well known the role that the study of tumor viruses has played in driving many of the greatest breakthroughs is not Without the insights gained by studying tumor viruses many significant theoretical advancements over the last four decades in cellular and molecular biology would not have been made More practically the study of tumor viruses has saved thousands if not millions of lives In Cancer Virus Hunters Gregory J Morgan traces the high points in the development of tumor virology from Peyton Rous s pioneering work on chicken tumors in 1909 to the successful development of an HPV vaccine for cervical cancer in 2006 Morgan offers a novel approach to understanding the
