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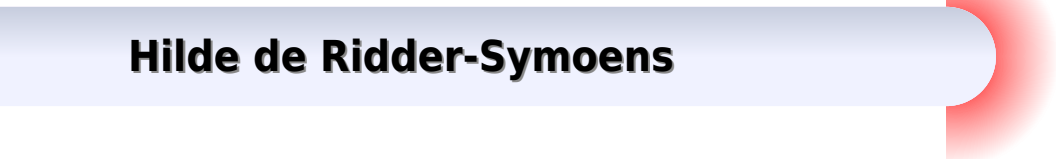

It then outlines the EUROAC project. This project has chosen three foci: governance, professionalisation, academic careers, to analyse changes in the work of the academic profession. The first results in the form of in depth literature reviews constitute the content of the book.
