African Audience Research Foundation SAARF 2013 the South African Development Index of the South African Institute of Race Relations 2011 and the Everyday Quality of Life Index Higgs 2007 The following indices measure wellbeing at a regional level the Quality of Metropolitan City Life in South Africa Index Naude et al 2009 the Non Economic Quality of Life Index at Sub National Levels Rossouw Naude 2008 and the Quality of Life Index of the Gauteng City Region Observatory GCRO 2011 Although these quality of life indices make distinctive contributions to the study field the focus of these studies is often to measure only objective or subjective quality of life or only economic or non economic quality of life rather than all of the above Furthermore many of the indices use equal weighting which does not necessarily reflect the priorities of the communities
