CHANGE – COLLAPSE OF GOVERNMENTS

Example 1 = Collapse of King Louis XVI's government ... read more in Unit 20!

THESIS – "The collapse of King Louis XVI's government in France had major effects."

TASK #1 – France in the late 1700s was divided into 3 social classes (the Three Estates).
(proof) The Third Estate (peasants and working people) paid 100% of the taxes, but only owned 30% of the land in France. Members of the Third Estate had few political rights and resented the King, clergy and nobility (top two estates). The problem was made worse by King Louis XVI. He could not deal with France's rising debt (bankruptcy) and inflation (high prices). Bad harvests led to inflated prices for bread, leading to hunger and suffering for the poor. Enlightenment ideals such as natural rights and government based on the consent of the governed (John Locke) inspired the French people to rise up against their government.

TASK #2 – A new constitution was written (The Declaration of the Rights of Man and of the Citizen) based on Enlightenment ideals. Robespierre began the Reign of Terror to spread fear in his political enemies. King Louis and Marie Antoinette were executed. Napoleon became the Emperor of a French Empire after conquering most of Europe. Nationalistic feelings and political stability increased afterwards.

THESIS – "The collapse of Czar Nicholas II's government in Russia also affected history."

TASK #1 – Russia failed to modernize as quickly as other European nations. Russia's loss
(proof) in the Russo-Japanese War and failure to industrialize left working class people angry. On Bloody Sunday, the Czar's troops killed hundreds of unarmed protesters. The Czar's policy of Russification (forcing minorities to adopt Russian culture) also caused resentment. World War I led to heavy military, food and fuel shortages in Russia, leading to a loss of faith in Czar Nicholas' policies. Peasant farmers and urban industrial workers were attracted to the ideas of Marxism (communism) because it called for a revolution led by the proletariat (working classes). Lenin's promises of "peace, land and bread" won their support.

TASK #2 – Czar Nicholas II was executed. Russia had a 3-year long civil war. The Reds won and transformed Russia into a single-party communist system. Russia became
