Roll putty into a bull shape. Pinch betureer, the shamb and fingertips. This exercise can also be performed with the thank and each finger separately. Reshape putty and repeat.





FINGER EXTENSION

Roll purty into cylinder and wrap purty around bent finger. Hold the putty with the other hand and by extending bent finger. The degree of resistance is sonbrailed by the thickness of the putty held over the fingertip.





THUMB PRESS

Roll purity into a ball and place in the palm, of your hand. Frees thurn's into the publy towards until finger. he shape putty and repeat.

THUMB EXTENSION

Form putty into a porecite shape. Place on table or mode over finger tips while fingers are bunched together. By to someal fingers apart.

With hand opened, press the putty with your thurst against your index linger. Brohage putty and repost eventure.
