A Place for Us Julia L. Musical Listening in the Age of Technological Reproduction Gianmario Borio, 2016-04-29 It is undeniable that technology has made a tangible impact on the nature of musical listening The new media have changed our relationship with music in a myriad of ways not least because the experience of listening can now be prolonged at will and repeated at any time and in any space Moreover among the more striking social phenomena ushered in by the technological revolution one cannot fail to mention music's current status as a commodity and popular music's unprecedented global reach In response to these new social and perceptual conditions the act of listening has diversified into a wide range of patterns of behaviour which seem to resist any attempt at unification Concentrated listening the form of musical reception fostered by Western art music now appears to be but one of the many ways in which audiences respond to organized sound Cinema for example has developed specific ways of combining images and sounds and more recently digital technology has redefined the standard forms of mass communication Information is aestheticized and music in turn is incorporated into pre-existing symbolic fields This volume the first in the series *Musical Cultures of the Twentieth Century* offers a wide-ranging exploration of the relations between sound technology and listening practices considered from the complementary perspectives of art music and popular music music theatre and multimedia composition and performance ethnographic and anthropological research

There's a Place For Us: The Musical Theatre Works of Leonard Bernstein Helen Smith, 2017-07-05 Leonard Bernstein was the quintessential American musician Through his careers as conductor pianist teacher and television personality he became known across the US and the world his flamboyance and theatricality making him a favourite with audiences if not with critics However he is perhaps best remembered as a composer

particularly of the musical *West Side Story* and for songs such as *America Tonight* and *Somewhere* Dr Helen Smith takes an in depth look at all eight of Bernstein's musical theatre works from the early *On the Town* written by the 26 year old composer at the start of his career to his second and last opera *A Quiet Place* in 1983 in between these two pieces he composed music for *Trouble in Tahiti* *Wonderful Town* *Candide* *West Side Story* *Mass* and *1600 Pennsylvania Avenue* These works are analysed and considered against a background of musical and social context as well as looking at Bernstein's other orchestral choral and chamber works One important aspect examined is Bernstein's use of motifs in his theatre compositions which takes them out of the realms of Broadway and into the sphere of symphonic writing Smith provides an indispensable overview of the musical theatre works of an eclectic composer and shows what it is that constitutes the Bernstein sound

Embodied Nostalgia Phoebe Rumsey, 2023-07-11 *Embodied Nostalgia* is a collection of interlocking case studies that focus on how social dance in musical theatre brings forth the dancer on stage as a site of embodied history cultural memory and nostalgia and asks what social dance is doing performatively dramaturgically and critically in musical theatre The case studies in this volume are all Broadway musicals set during the Jazz Age 1910-1950 however performed and produced after that time creating a spectrum of nostalgic impulses that are interrogated for social and political resonance

and meaning All reflect the fractures or changes in the social dance when brought to the stage and expose the complexities of the embodied nostalgia broadly interpreted as the physicalizing of community memories longings and historical meaning the dances carry with them Particular attention is focused on the Black ownership of the social dances and the subsequent appropriation cultural theft and forgotten legacies By approaching musical theatre through this lens of social dance always already deeply connected to notions of class and race and the politics of choreography therein a unique and necessary method to describing discussing and critically evaluating the body in motion in musical theatre is put forth **Souls at Risk** Nancy Vernon Kelly,2019-12-31 Rooms of Nancy Vernon Kelly s childhood home in Hollywood California provide scaffolding for Souls at Risk a memoir about the roots and consequences of her writer producer father s sudden turn to right wing extremism Radicalization didn t occur in a vacuum Its grip had clear public and personal roots and consequences The narrative pivots around a 1960 concert the author s father produced in San Diego for blacklisted folksinger Pete Seeger When Seeger refused to sign a loyalty oath to use a public high school auditorium the American Legion accused him of being a communist and protested to the San Diego School Board Although the concert went on and Kelly sang along the fallout continued for many years entrenched in Cold War American Soviet hostility Souls at Risk weaves together the long view of a personal public and historical story that embodies both the disruption of extremism and the disruption of grace While remembering the unwelcome parts of life with hateful extremism the author also delights in the memory of experiences and people who kept her fledgling soul from completely flattening out in a turbulent time Indeed the sweetest touch of mercy arrived in Kelly s inbox almost fifty years after the concert **Angels in Red Suspenders** Ralph Milton,1998-09 Ralph Milton is an angel He may not look the part but then who does In Angels in Red Suspenders Milton shares stories of everyday miracles hope and the discovery of meaning With characteristic wit and humour he offers readers food for the spirit
