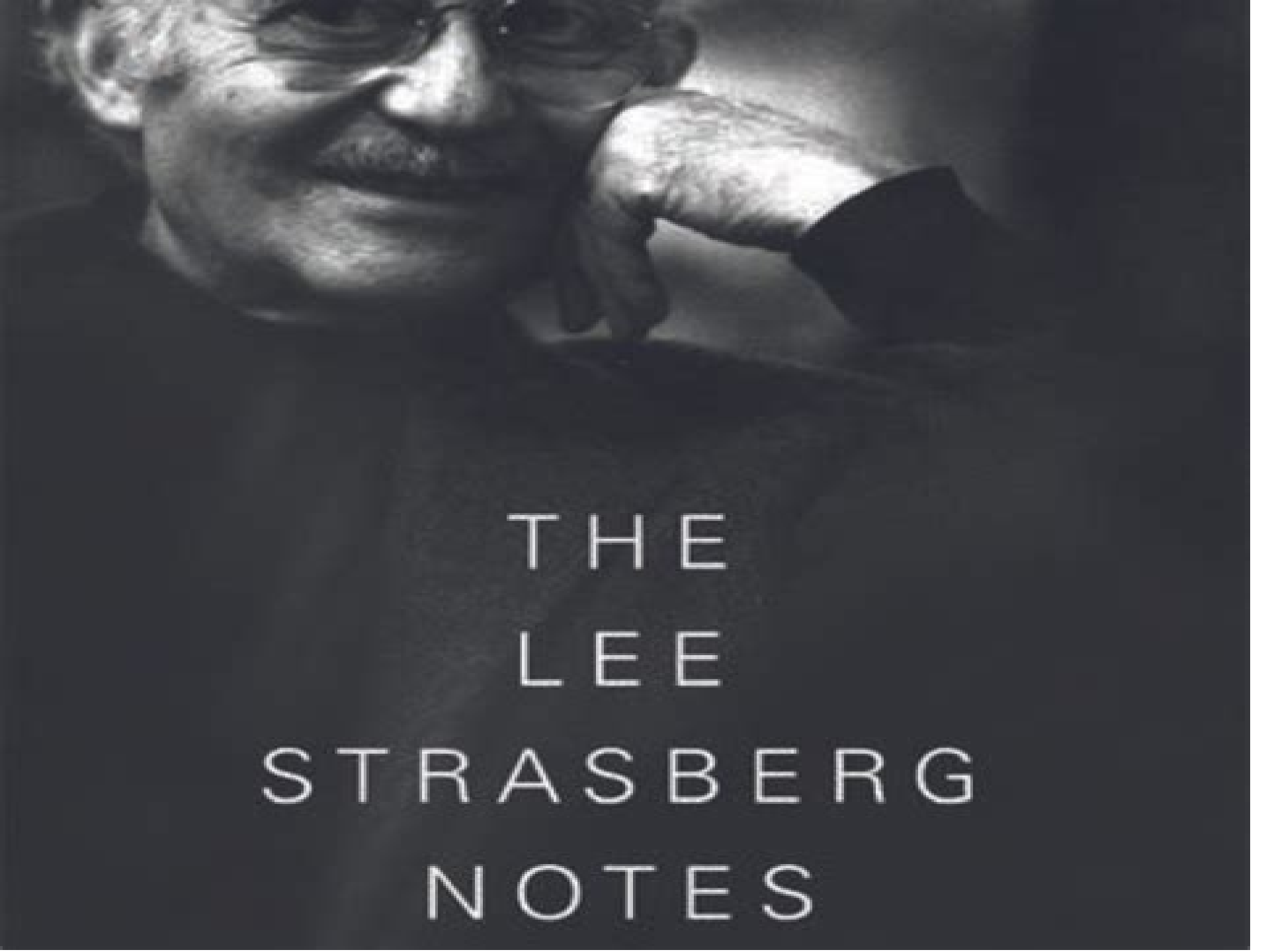

Beyond Method Scott Balcerzak, 2018-06-25 Explores the methodologies and influence of acting teacher Stella Adler on her male students Stella Adler 1901-92 trained many well known American actors yet throughout much of her career her influence was overshadowed by Lee Strasberg director of the Actors Studio In *Beyond Method* Stella Adler and the Male Actor Scott Balcerzak focuses on Adler's teachings and how she challenged Strasberg's

psychological focus on the actor's self by promoting an empathetic and socially engaged approach to performance. Employing archived studio transcripts and recordings, Balcerzak examines Adler's lessons in technique, characterization, and script analysis as they reflect the background of the teacher, illustrating her time studying with Constantin Stanislavski, her Yiddish Theatre upbringing, and her encyclopedic knowledge of drama. Through this lens, *Beyond Method* resituates the performances of some of her famous male students through an expansive understanding of the discourses of acting. The book begins by providing an overview of the gender and racial classifications associated with the male Method actor and discussing white maleness in the mid-twentieth century. The first chapter explores the popular press's promotion of Method stars during the 1950s as an extension of Strasberg's rise in celebrity. At the same time, Adler's methodology was defining actor performance as a form of social engagement rather than just personal expression, welcoming an analysis of onscreen masculinity as culturally fluid. The chapters that follow serve as case studies of some of Adler's most famous students in notable roles: Marlon Brando in *A Streetcar Named Desire* (1951) and *The Missouri Breaks* (1976), Robert De Niro in *Taxi Driver* (1976), Henry Winkler in *Happy Days* (1974-84), and Mark Ruffalo in *The Avengers: Age of Ultron* (2015). Balcerzak concludes that the presence of Adler altered the trajectory of onscreen maleness through a promotion of a relatively complex view of gender identity not found in other classrooms. *Beyond Method* considers Stella Adler as not only an effective teacher of acting but also an engaging and original thinker, providing us a new way to consider performances of maleness on the screen. Film and theater scholars as well as those interested in gender studies are sure to benefit from this thorough study.

important sources of the Stanislavsky System Yoga its practice and philosophy Sergei Tcherkasski carefully collects records on Yoga in Stanislavsky s writings from different periods and discusses hidden references which are not explained by Stanislavsky himself due to the censorship in his day Vivid examples of Yoga based training from the rehearsal practice of the Moscow Art Theatre and many of Stanislavsky s studios the First Studio in 1910s the Second Studio and Opera Studio of the Bolshoi Theatre in 1920s Opera Dramatic Studio in 1930s are provided The focus of Tcherkasski s research consists of a comparative reading of the Stanislavsky System and Yogi Ramacharaka s books which were a main source for Stanislavsky Accordingly Tcherkasski analyzes elements of the System based on Yoga principles Among them are relaxation of muscles muscular release communication and prana emission of rays and reception of rays beaming of aura sending of prana attention visualizations mental images Special attention is paid to the idea of the superconscious in Yoga and in Ramacharaka s and Stanislavsky s theories Tcherkasski s wide ranging analysis has resulted in new and intriguing discoveries about the Russian master Furthermore he reveals the extent to which Stanislavsky anticipated modern discoveries in neurobiology and cognitive science In this book Tcherkasski acts as a researcher historian theatre director and experienced acting teacher He argues that some forty per cent of basic exercises in any Stanislavsky based actor training program of today are rooted in Yoga Actors teachers and students will find it interesting to discover that they are following in the footsteps of Yoga in their everyday Stanislavsky based training and rehearsals

When Marilyn Met the Queen

Michelle Morgan, 2022-02-17 England It seemed to be raining the whole time Or maybe it was me MARILYN MONROE In July 1956 Marilyn Monroe arrived in London on honeymoon with her husband Arthur Miller to make The Sleeping Prince later released as The Prince and the Showgirl with Laurence Olivier When the couple arrived at London Airport they were looking forward to a peaceful stay Marilyn would work during the day at Pinewood Studios while Arthur would write Then in the evening the couple would be able to relax together in their private English country cottage It didn t quite turn out that way The cottage was actually a mansion which belonged to Lord Drogheda the managing director of the Financial Times Raised in tiny hotel rooms and apartments Marilyn felt herself being watched She was by Lord Drogheda s servants who were selling stories to the papers When filming began it was a disaster Director Joshua Logan had written to Olivier offering advice on how to handle Marilyn as an actress but Olivier ignored him Instead he condescended to her in his introduction to the cast pooh poohed her views on acting and dismissed her stage fright as an inconvenience Marilyn grew to hate Olivier with a passion the feeling was mutual Marilyn found herself torn between settling into married life being a curiosity for the frequently hostile British press and her work on The Prince and the Showgirl She took solace in small acts of kindness from members of the public and a new fascination with Queen Elizabeth Marilyn made a point of adopting some of the Queen s favourite brands buying gloves from Cornelia James perfume from Floris and switching from Chanel No 5 to Yardley s Lavender Marilyn made a point of asking the film s PR manager to add a royal meeting to her schedule but each day Olivier
