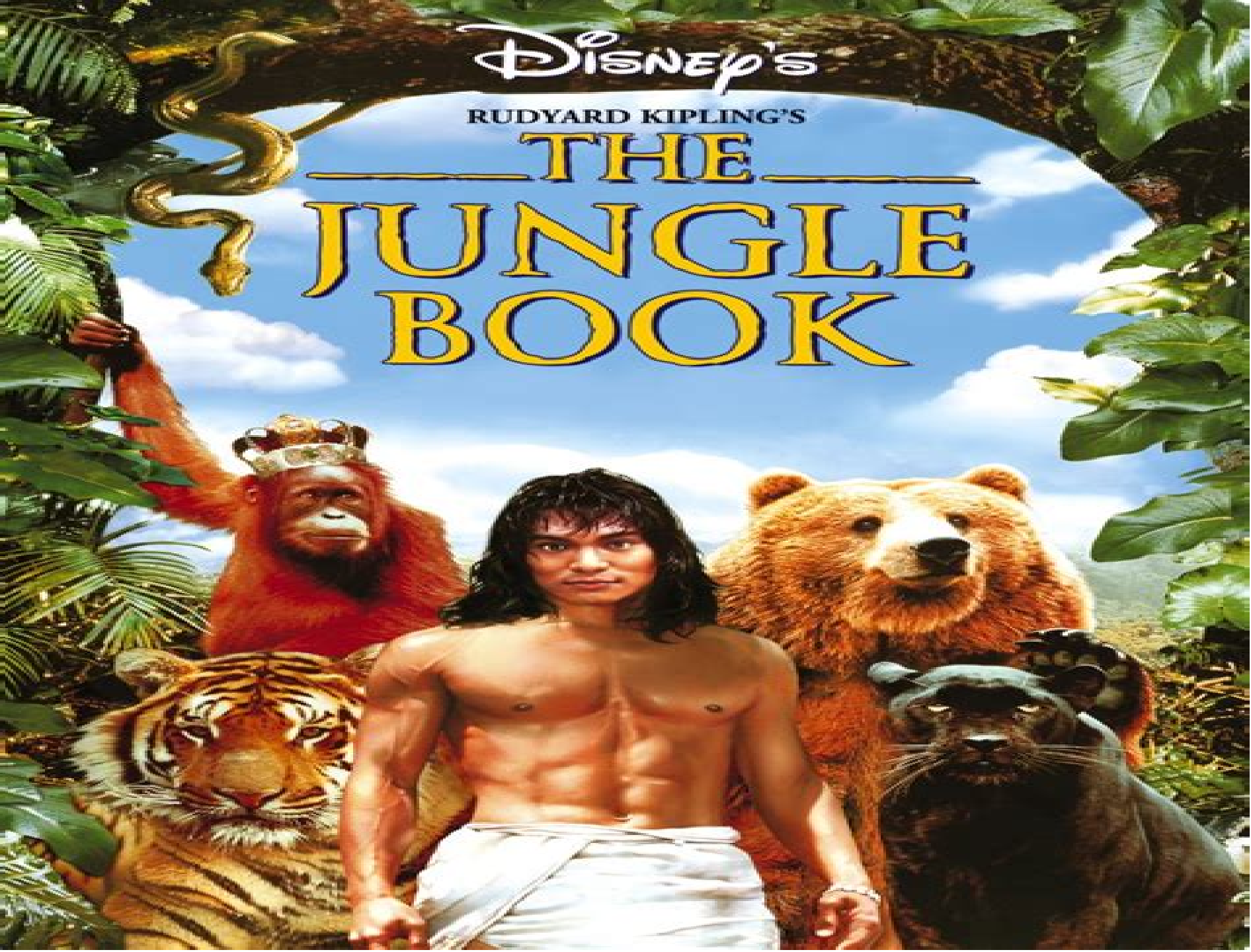

The Jungle Book and the Second Jungle Book Rudyard Kipling,2017-10-13 The Jungle Book 1894 is a collection of stories by English author Rudyard Kipling The stories were first published in magazines in 1893 94 The original publications contain illustrations some by the author s father John Lockwood Kipling Kipling was born in India and spent the first six years of his childhood there After about ten years in England he went back to India and worked there for about six and a half years These stories were written when
