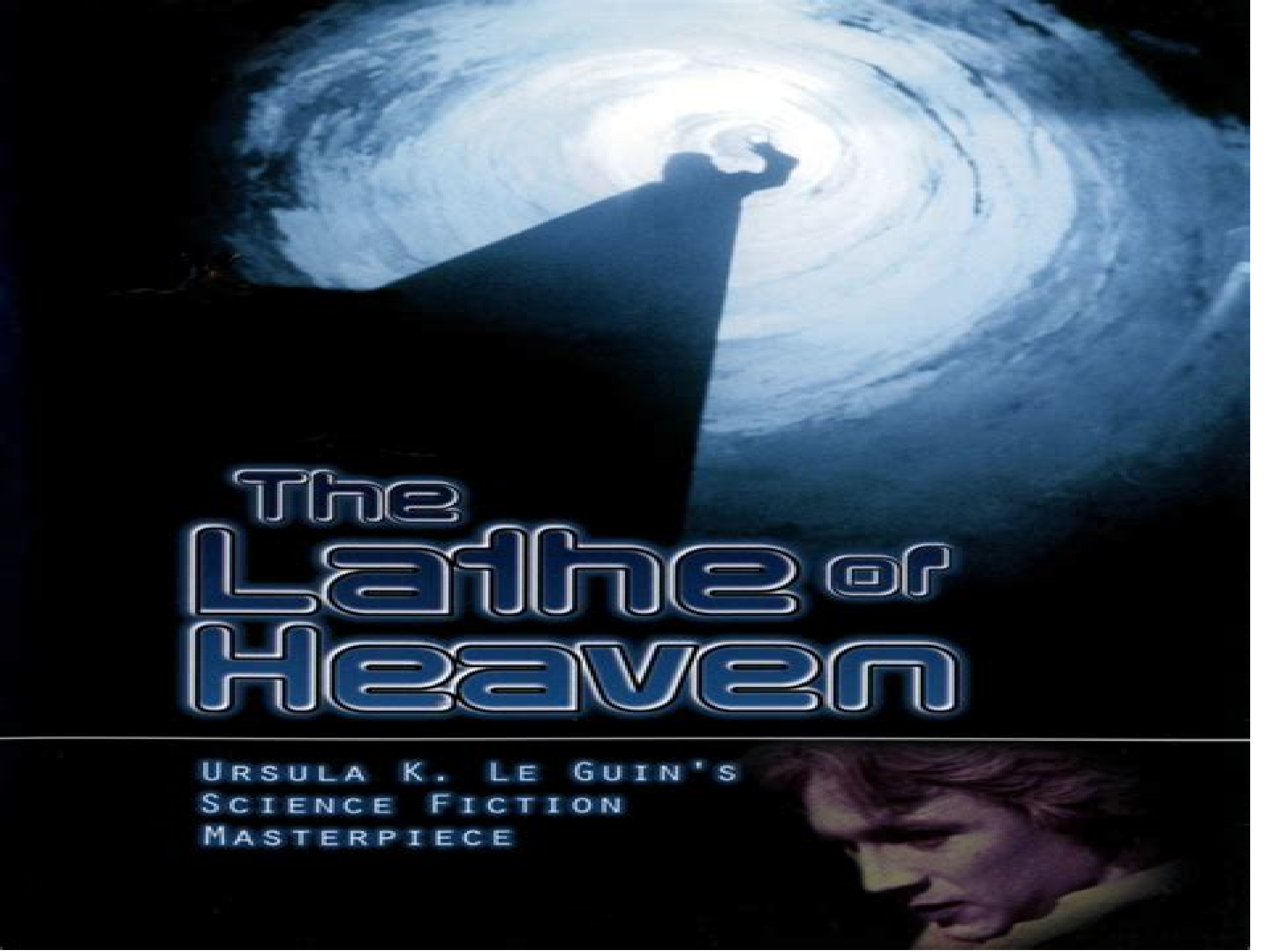

The long out of print *Searoad Chronicles of Klatsand* 1991 is a Winesburg Ohio like series of linked stories set in a small vacation town on the Oregon coast where some of the characters have come for a weekend and some for longer but all are pilgrims in the grip of inexpressible longings. And Le Guin's final powerfully feminist novel *Lavinia* 2008 reimagines Virgil's *Aeneid* from the perspective of a woman who in poet's telling never speaks a word.
