Mahan's middle name honors the father of West Point, Sylvanus Thayer. Mahan attended Saint James School, an Episcopal college preparatory academy in western Maryland. He then studied at Columbia for two years, where he was a member of the Philolexian Society debating club. Against the better judgment of his father, Mahan then entered the Naval Academy, where he graduated second in his class in 1859. Commissioned as a lieutenant in 1861, Mahan served the Union in the American Civil War as an officer on USS *Worcester*, Congress, *Pocahontas*, and *James Adger*, and as an instructor at the Naval Academy. In 1865, he was promoted to lieutenant commander and then to commander in 1872 and captain in 1885. As commander of the USS *Wachusett*, he was stationed at Callao, Peru, protecting US interests during the final stages of the War of the Pacific.
