Department of Political Science, 2012 ABSTRACT The end of the Cold War marks the beginning of the policy shift from strategic stability the policy that guided U S and Soviet nuclear doctrine and acquisition strategies throughout the Cold War to a new strategy privileging ballistic missile defence BMD Prior to this shift BMD programs were considered by both sides to be financially untenable technologically unreliable and dangerously destabilising and potentially catastrophic primarily because they risked undermining the stability of a second strike capability and other stabilizing features of mutually assured destruction MAD I argue that this new environment is making missile defence a viable alternative to massive nuclear arsenals In this new security environment Canada remains an anomaly Canadian officials support NATO BMD programs but reject any bilateral and or bi national negotiations with Washington on continental BMD for North America Contrary to the conventional wisdom I argue that Canada through the North American Aerospace Defence Command NORAD agreement on early warning radars is in fact part of missile defence
