THE COLD WAR IN EUROPE

- Before the end of World War II, the Western European countries and the Soviet Union began to grow suspicious of each other.
- The lack of trust and co-operation between the USA and USSR in particular, led to what is commonly referred to as the Cold War.

What was the Cold War?

- The Cold War was a series of mounting tensions between the two super-powers, each representing differing ideologies.
- On the one hand the USA symbolised a capitalist, democratic system and the USSR or Russia, stood for the principles of communism and a one-party system of government.
- The struggles between the two sides, the East vs the West, was an indirect conflict and usually at considerable risk to global peace.
- At times, the cold war became 'warm' and threatened to develop into full scale, 'hot' war - but one of the two powers always backed down at the last minute and thus the cold war continued for a lengthy period.

Origins of the Cold War

- After World War II, the Allied Powers had several conferences to discuss the future of Germany and the reconstruction of Europe.
- In February 1945, the Yalta Conference was held in the Soviet Union and the following was decided upon by the Big Three (Russia, USA, and Britain):
 - **That Germany be divided into four Zones of occupation - Russian, American, British and French.**
 - **Berlin, the capital of Germany, which was situated in the Russian Zone, be divided into four sections, one for each of the 4 major**

Canada's Residential Schools: The History, Part 2, 1939 to 2000 Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada, 2015-12-09 Between 1867 and 2000 the Canadian government sent over 150 000 Aboriginal children to residential schools across the country Government officials and missionaries agreed that in order to civilize and

Christianize Aboriginal children it was necessary to separate them from their parents and their home communities For children life in these schools was lonely and alien Discipline was harsh and daily life was highly regimented Aboriginal languages and cultures were denigrated and suppressed Education and technical training too often gave way to the drudgery of doing the chores necessary to make the schools self sustaining Child neglect was institutionalized and the lack of supervision created situations where students were prey to sexual and physical abusers Legal action by the schools former students led to the creation of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada in 2008 The product of over six years of research the Commission s final report outlines the history and legacy of the schools and charts a pathway towards reconciliation Canada s Residential Schools The History Part 2 1939 to 2000 carries the story of the residential school system from the end of the Great Depression to the closing of the last remaining schools in the late 1990s It demonstrates that the underfunding and unsafe living conditions that characterized the early history of the schools continued into an era of unprecedented growth and prosperity for most Canadians A miserly funding formula meant that into the late 1950s school meals fell short of the Canada Food Rules Overcrowding poor sanitation and a failure to adhere to fire safety rules were common problems throughout this period While government officials had come to view the schools as costly and inefficient the churches were reluctant to countenance their closure It was not until the late 1960s that the federal government finally wrested control of the system away from the churches Government plans to turn First Nations education over to the provinces met with opposition from Aboriginal organizations that were seeking Indian Control of Indian Education Following parent led occupation of a school in Alberta many of the remaining schools came under Aboriginal administration The closing of the schools coincided with a growing number of convictions of former staff members on charges of sexually abusing students These trials revealed the degree to which sexual abuse at the schools had been covered up in the past Former students who came to refer to themselves as Survivors established regional and national organizations and provided much of the leadership for the campaign that led to the federal government issuing in 2008 an apology to the former students and their families

Hedican, 2023-03-30 In January 1832 in the most southern part of Ontario s James Bay an elderly Cree man by the name of Quapakay was told by the spirits of the shaking tent that in order to survive the winter he was required to spoil the post at Hannah Bay a Hudson s Bay Company goose hunting station Following the directions of the spirits Quapakay and his sons carried out this ill fated task resulting in the deaths of sixteen occupants of the Hannah Bay post Now known as the Hannah Bay Massacre the victims included fur trader William Corrigan the postmaster and his wife and seven other Indigenous people When the Spirit Calls explores the social cultural and historical context in which the Hannah Bay tragedy took place as gleaned from the Hudson Bay Company s archival records and elucidations by Cree oral traditions The research is the culmination of over forty years of investigation by Edward J Hedican in Indigenous communities from the mid 1970s to the present day In the book Hedican aims to uncover the circumstances behaviours and attitudes that led to the slaughter When the Spirit Calls sheds light on the racist attitudes held by the white settler population towards Indigenous people attitudes that were prevalent in our colonial past and that continue to this very day
