

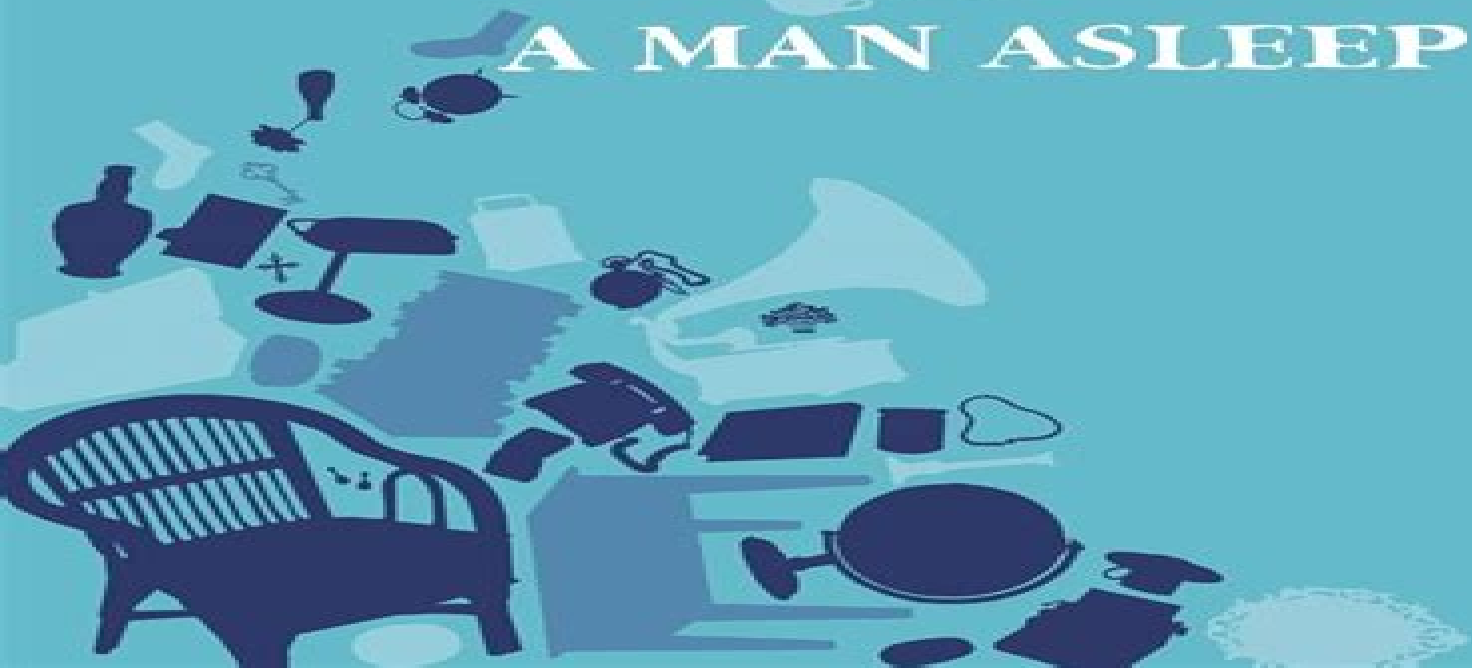

Irish Housing Design 1950 - 1980 Brian Ward, Michael Pike, Gary Boyd, 2019-12-11 This book examines the architectural design of housing projects in Ireland from the mid twentieth century This period represented a high point in the construction of the Welfare State project where the idea that architecture could and should shape and define community and social life was not yet considered problematic Exploring a period when Ireland embraced the free market and the end of economic protectionism the book is a series of case studies supported by critical narratives Little known but of high quality the schemes presented in this volume are by architects whose designs helped determine future architectural thinking in Ireland and elsewhere Aimed at academics students and researchers the book is accompanied by new drawings and over 100 full colour images with the example studies demonstrating rich architectural responses to a shifting landscape

Useless Activity Christopher Webb, 2022-07-01 Using a broad range of archival material from Washington University St Louis the University of Glasgow and the British Library *Useless Activity* Work Leisure and British Avant Garde Fiction 1960 1975 is the first study to ask why the experimental writing of the 1960s and 1970s appears so fraught with anxiety about its own uselessness before suggesting that this very anxiety was symptomatic of a unique period in British literary history when traditional notions about literary work and what worked in terms of literature were being radically scrutinised and reassessed The study is divided into five chapters with three of those dedicated to the close analysis of work produced by three writers representative of the 1960s British avant garde Eva Figes 1932 2012 B S Johnson 1933 1973 and Alexander Trocchi 1925 1984 The book argues that these writers preoccupations with concepts related to work such as leisure debt and various forms of neglected labour like housework allow us to rethink the British avant garde s relation to realism while posing broader questions about the production and value of post war literary avant gardism more generally *Useless Activity* proposes that only with an understanding of the British avant garde s engagement with the idea of work and its various corollaries can we appreciate these writers move away from certain forms of literary realism and their contribution to the development of the modern British novel during the mid twentieth century

Henri Lefebvre on Space Lukasz Stanek, 2011 Shows how Lefebvre s theory of space developed out of direct engagement with architecture urbanism and urban sociology

The Age of New Waves James Tweedie, 2013-09-02 The Age of New Waves examines the origins of the concept of the new wave in 1950s France and the proliferation of new waves in world cinema over the past three decades The book suggests that youth cities and the construction of a global market have been the catalysts for the cinematic new waves of the past half century It begins by describing the enthusiastic engagement between French nouvelle vague filmmakers and a globalizing American cinema and culture during the modernization of France after World War II It then charts the growing and ultimately explosive disenchantment with the aftermath of that massive social economic and spatial

transformation in the late 1960s Subsequent chapters focus on films and visual culture from Taiwan and contemporary mainland China during the 1980s and 1990s and they link the recent propagation of new waves on the international film festival circuit to the economic miracles and consumer revolutions accompanying the process of globalization While it travels from France to East Asia the book follows the transnational movement of a particular model of cinema organized around mise en sc ne or the interaction of bodies objects and spaces within the frame rather than montage or narrative The master shot style of directors like Hou Hsiao Hsien Tsai Ming Liang and Jia Zhangke has reinvented a crucial but overlooked tendency in new wave film and this cinema of mise en sc ne has become a key aesthetic strategy for representing the changing relationships between people and the material world during the rise of a global market The final chapter considers the interaction between two of the most global phenomena in recent film history the transnational art cinema and Hollywood and it searches for traces of an American New Wave

The Pictorial Third Liliane Louvel, 2018-05-23 *The Pictorial Third* An Essay into Intermedial Criticism examines the extent to which poetry intertwines with painting and the visual at large and studies the singular relationship established between language and image observing the modalities and workings of what is termed intermedial transposition By following a critical method of the close analysis of texts the book examines to what extent the pictorial tool may be of help to analyze literary texts and thus enlarge and enrich literary criticism Examining the technical notions typical of the medium and its history including perspective framing colour anamorphosis trompe l il Veronica veil still life portrait figure illusion apparatus genres and styles this volume presents a pragmatics of image in text and of the visual in text as an operative tool This pictorial reading necessarily includes synesthesia and the senses it also functions as a reading event or what happens to one when one unawares encounters a picture be it present in the book or the object of an ekphrasis Thus the body is eventually given back a role to play The sensitive approach has its own resonances and the eye or the gaze sometimes sees double in such intermedially oriented texts This volume proposes to identify the pictorial third as the phenomenon which can be apprehended in terms of effect or affect not only as a concept

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On Design Tevfik Balcioglu, 2024-02-22.
