- --Falling Action- the part of the story where things fall back into place
- -- Resolution- the end of the story
- -- Protagonist- main character
- -- Antagonist- opposing character or force (the bad guy)
- Theme the underlying message or universal idea of the story. Ex. Man vs. nature, responsibility
- --Symbol- an item used to express something else. Ex. A flog represents our country.
- --Point of view- perspective from which a story is written.

First person-told by character or narrator. Uses pronouns- I, me, we

Second person- tells reader what to do or allows reader to make choices. Uses pronouns you, your

Third person- told by outsider -Uses pronouns he, she, it, they. There are three types of perspective for third person.

Third person omniscient- the narrator knows all that is happening and know all characters thoughts & actions.

Third person limited- the narrator knows one of the characters thoughts and action, but not all

Third person objective- the narrator tells the story but the only the characters can know their thoughts

**Irony-**When events in the story turn out differently than expected. There are three types of irony

Dramatic irony- when the reader or audience knows more about the events than a character
