into critical discourse Tracking the critical movements of this problem Hess provides an inherited transformational logic as a feasible path for integrating a performative mode into multidimensional learning This approach emerges as a distinctly relational embodied multidimensional and non correlational performative mode theology that breaks new ground in the contemporary theological landscape As an implicitly trinitarian method rooted in the relationality of God this non correlational method offers a practical theological contribution to the discipline of Christian spirituality newly claimed here as a discipline of transformative teaching learning through the highly contextualized and self implicated scholar into relationally formed communities and ultimately into the world
