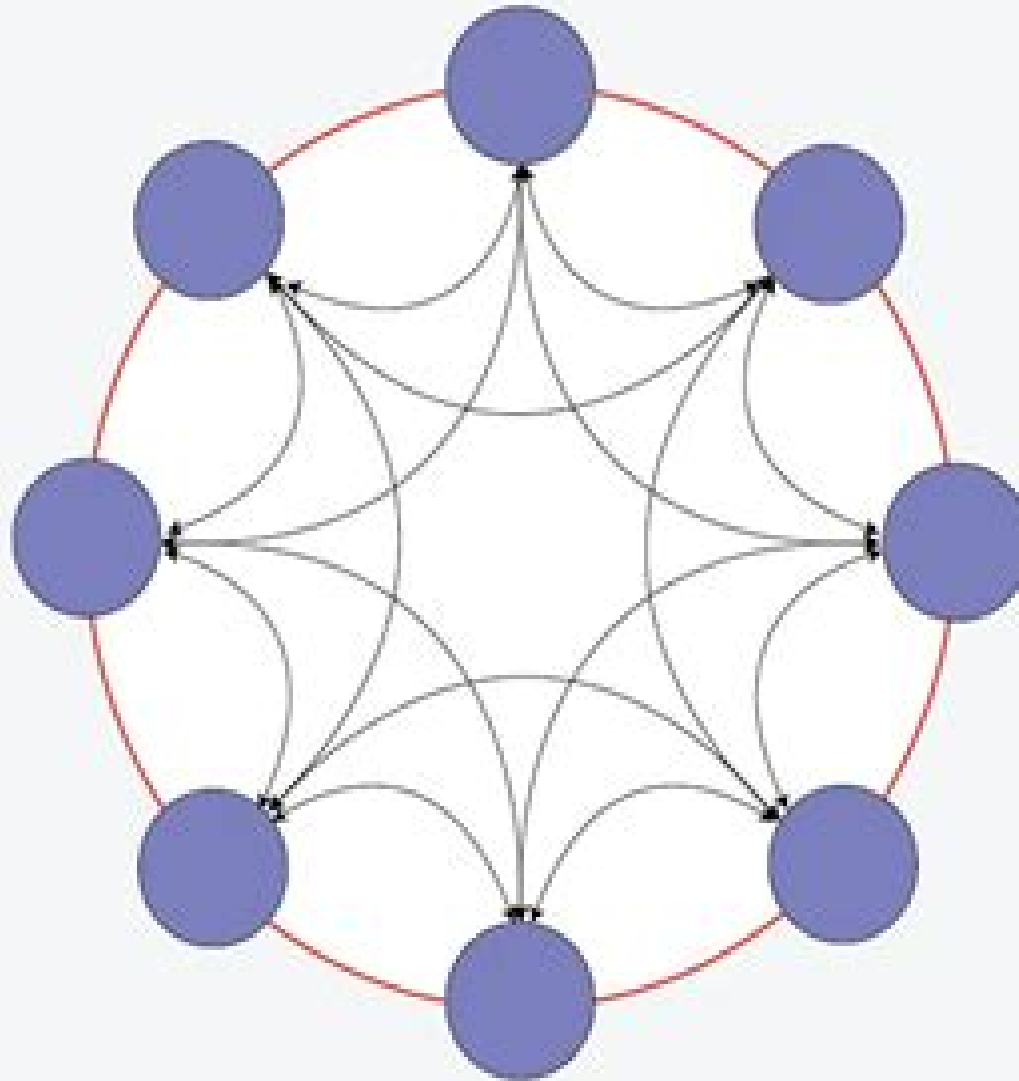

Structured Peer-to-Peer Systems Dmitry Korzun, Andrei Gurtov, 2012-11-12 The field of structured P2P systems has seen fast growth upon the introduction of Distributed Hash Tables DHTs in the early 2000s The first proposals including Chord Pastry Tapestry were gradually improved to cope with scalability locality and security issues By utilizing the processing and bandwidth resources of end users the P2P approach enables high performance of data distribution which is hard to achieve with traditional client server architectures The P2P computing community is also being actively utilized for software updates to the Internet P2PSIP VoIP video on demand and distributed backups The recent introduction of the identifier locator split proposal for future Internet architectures poses another important application for DHTs namely mapping between host permanent identity and changing IP address The growing complexity and scale of modern P2P systems requires the introduction of hierarchy and intelligence in routing of requests Structured Peer to Peer Systems covers fundamental issues in organization optimization and tradeoffs of present large scale structured P2P systems as well as provides principles analytical models and simulation methods applicable in designing future systems Part I presents the state of the art of structured P2P systems popular DHT topologies and protocols and the design challenges for efficient P2P network topology organization routing scalability and security Part II shows that local strategies with limited knowledge per peer provide the highest scalability level subject to reasonable performance and security constraints Although the strategies are local their efficiency is due to elements of hierarchical organization which appear in many DHT designs that traditionally are considered as flat ones Part III describes methods to gradually enhance the local view limit when a peer is capable to operate with larger knowledge still partial about the entire system These methods were formed in the evolution of hierarchical organization from flat DHT networks to hierarchical DHT architectures look ahead routing and topology aware ranking Part IV highlights some known P2P based experimental systems and commercial applications in the modern Internet The discussion clarifies the importance of P2P technology for building present and future Internet systems

Architecture and Methods for Flexible Content Management in Peer-to-Peer Systems Udo Bartlang, 2010-04-11 At times when the IT manager's best friend is systems consolidation which is a euphemism for centralisation it may come somewhat as a surprise for you that this book investigates decentralisation in the context of content management systems It may seem quite obvious that content will and should be managed by the party who creates and owns the content and hence should be held in a somewhat centralised and managed location However over the past few years we have been witnesses of some important trends and developments which call for novel ways of thinking about content management and maybe even broader about computer systems in general First ongoing business globalization creates natural distribution of information at a corporate level as well as decentralization of control over business resources and business processes Changing alliances with partners require flexible architectures for content management that can adapt to changing constellations roles and access rights Second the need for outsourcing and

resource efficiency has brought about concepts of virtualization recently culminating in the cloud computing buzzword Virtualization of content management services requires tremely scalable and exible underlying information and communication architectures These kinds of solutions are theoretically and practically impossible to implement based on c tralised client server architectures Third we are currently experiencing a dramatic shift in the roles of consumers in the Internet The times have gone when quality content was only delivered by publishers and news agencies Wikis and other Web 2 0 tools empower consumers to produce and publish their personal content Peer-to-Peer Systems Peter Druschel, Frans Kaashoek, Antony Rowstron, 2002-01-01 Peer to peer has emerged as a promising new paradigm for large scale distributed computing The International Workshop on Peer to Peer Systems IPTPS aimed to provide a forum for researchers active in peer to peer computing to discuss the state of the art and to identify key research challenges The goal of the workshop was to examine peer to peer technologies appli tions and systems and also to identify key research issues and challenges that lie ahead In the context of this workshop peer to peer systems were characterized as being decentralized self organizing distributed systems in which all or most communication is symmetric The program of the workshop was a combination of invited talks pres tations of position papers and discussions covering novel peer to peer appli tions and systems peer to peer infrastructure security in peer to peer systems anonymity and anti censorship performance of peer to peer systems and wo load characterization for peer to peer systems To ensure a productive workshop environment attendance was limited to 55 participants Each potential participant was asked to submit a position paper of 5 pages that exposed a new problem advocated a speci c solution or reported on actual experience We received 99 submissions and were able to accept 31 Participants were invited based on the originality technical merit and topical relevance of their submissions as well as the likelihood that the ideas expressed in their submissions would lead to insightful technical discussions at the workshop

Peer-to-Peer Systems III Geoffrey M. Voelker, Scott Shenker, 2005-01-12 On February 26 27 2004 the 3rd International Workshop on Peer to Peer S tems IPTPS 2004 brought researchers and practitioners together to discuss the latest developments in peer to peer technologies applications and systems As the third workshop in the series IPTPS 2004 continued the success of the previous workshops in pioneering the state of the art in peer to peer systems and identifying key research challenges in the area The workshop received 145 submissions in the form of ve page position papers As with previous workshops submissions went through two rounds of reviews by an international program committee of 14 experts from industry and academia In the rst round each submission received two reviews In the second round we focused our attention on submissions with either positive reviews or with reviews that expressed substantially di erent opinions In addition to the technical merit the reviewing process emphasized originality and the potential of the submission to lead to interesting discussions during the workshop In the end the program committee selected a workshop program of 27 papers covering a wider range of topics including new peer to peer applications advances in routing load balancing searching as well as

transport mobility and other networking topics Authors revised accepted position papers to six pages for the workshop program and made a final round of revision for this volume The workshop was composed of eight sessions that spanned two days To focus discussions attendance was limited to 67 participants and included sessions

The total acceptance rate of the main conference was 37%. For this conference we received 576 submissions. Each was reviewed by two independent members of the International Program Committee. After carefully evaluating their originality and quality we accepted 57 regular papers and 84 short papers. The acceptance rate of regular papers was 10%. The total acceptance rate was 25%.

It tries to bring together the international research community in a top quality event that covers all the areas of computer security ranging from theory to applications. ESORICS 2010 was the 15th edition of the event. It was held in Athens Greece September 20-22, 2010. The conference received 201 submissions. The papers went through a careful review process. In a first round, each paper received three independent reviews. For the majority of the papers, an electronic discussion was also organized to arrive at the final decision. As a result of the review process, 42 papers were selected for the final program, resulting in an acceptance rate of as low as 21%. The authors of accepted papers were requested to revise their papers based on the comments received. The program was completed with an invited talk by Udo Helmreich, Executive Director of ENISA European Network and Information Security Agency. ESORICS 2010 was organized under the aegis of three Ministries of the Government of Greece: namely a) the Ministry of Infrastructure, Transport and Networks; b) the General Secretariat for Information Systems of the Ministry of Economy and Finance; and c) the General Secretariat for the Governance of the Ministry of Interior Decentralization.

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
