It is an intense personal account of more than a quarter of a century on the front lines in the ultra high tech hot zone lab that McCormick was instrumental in creating at the Centers for Disease Control in Atlanta as well as in the most primitive places on the planet where the local climate, terrain and politics can kill as easily as any disease. In the villages of Zaire and Sudan, the ghettos and rain forest of Brazil and the nomadic settlements of northern Pakistan, the cutting edge of science meets the deadly universe of viral disease. The elite corps of virus hunters who dare to penetrate these realms combine the unquenchable curiosity and raw guts of intrepid explorers with the training of top level scientists, the hunch, playing passion of master sleuths and the compassion of truly great physicians. Told in intimate detail by two of the world's best known virologists, colleagues, collaborators, husband and wife, **Level 4** is a journey across the world and into many strange new worlds from the seductive beauty of equatorial Africa, a limitless reservoir of infection to the confines of the all but invisible field of the electron microscope. While other books have offered hot zones, sick monkeys and grim statistics, **Level 4** brings home from the world of the virus the human stories of those who lived and those who died.

Cancer Virus Hunters Gregory J. Morgan, 2022-08-02. Traces the history of the study of tumor viruses and its role in driving breakthroughs in cancer research. Worldwide, approximately one fifth of human cancers are caused by tumor viruses, with hepatitis B virus and HPV being the leading culprits. While the explosive growth in molecular biology in the late twentieth century is well known, the role that the study of tumor viruses has played in driving many of the greatest breakthroughs is not. Without the insights gained by studying tumor viruses, many significant theoretical advancements over the last four decades in cellular and molecular biology would not have been made. More practically, the study of tumor viruses has saved thousands if not millions of lives. In *Cancer Virus Hunters*, Gregory J. Morgan traces the high points in the development of tumor virology from Peyton Rous's pioneering work on chicken tumors in 1909 to the successful development of an HPV vaccine for cervical cancer in 2006. A Tale of Two Viruses Neeraja Sankaran,2021-03-09 In 1965 French microbiologist Andr Lwoff was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for his work on lysogeny one of the two types of viral life cycles which resolved a contentious debate among scientists about the nature of viruses A Tale of Two Viruses is the first study of medical virology to compare the history of two groups of medically important viruses bacteriophages which infect bacteria and sarcoma agents which cause cancer and the importance of Lwoff s discovery to our modern understanding of what a virus is Although these two groups of viruses may at first glance appear to have little in common they share uniquely parallel histories The lysogenic cycle unlike the lytic enables viruses to replicate in the host cell without destroying it and to remain dormant in a cell s genetic material indefinitely or until induced by UV radiation But until Lwoff s discovery of the mechanism of lysogeny microbiologist Felix d Herelle and pathologist Peyton Rous who themselves first discovered and argued for the viral identity of bacteriophages and certain types of cancer respectively faced opposition from contemporary researchers who would not accept their findings By following the research trajectories of the two virus groups Sankaran takes a novel approach to the history of the development of the field of medical virology considering both the flux in scientific concepts over time and the broader scientific landscapes or styles that shaped those ideas and practices

Conceiving of disaster as intersubjective ethics between humans and nonhuman alterity, forces of nature, errant technology, monsters, ghosts, and other entities, it analyses how formal techniques and narrative strategies render encounters in which human protagonists are confronted with the threat of death and respond in ways that can be instructive for our planet's present juncture.

But in baby-booming America, increasingly suburban, family-oriented, and hygiene-obsessed, the specter of polio, like the specter of the atomic bomb, soon became a cloud of terror over daily life. Both a gripping scientific suspense story and a provocative social and cultural history, *Polio* opens a fresh window onto postwar America.
