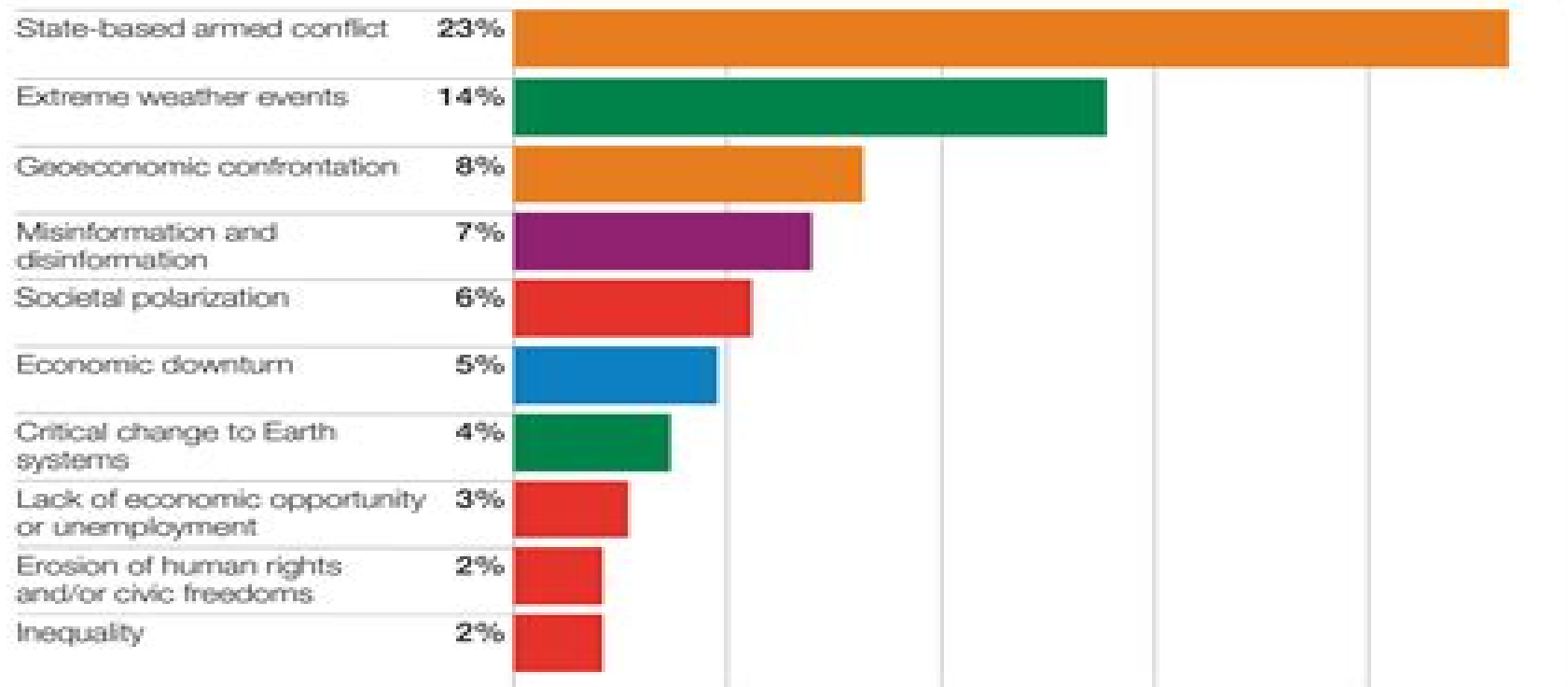


Current Risk Landscape
