

Class Notes:

- What are the energetic needs of organisms?
- How do organisms interact in ways that meet their energy needs, including predator-prey interactions, trophic levels, and food webs?
- How do these interactions, especially changes in populations of keystone species, influence the structure and function of ecological communities?
- Producers bring energy into an ecosystem through photosynthesis; consumers acquire energy from producers; smaller, sessile consumers get eaten by larger, mobile consumers
- Primary producers → Primary Consumers → Secondary Consumers → Tertiary Consumers
- Only ~10% of energy is transferred up each step of the pyramid **because of the 2nd law of thermodynamics (entropy)**
 - Energy is lost as waste, heat, and living (cellular respiration)
- Regulators- keep internal environment constant
 - Regulate inside of the body when the outside changes
 - Maintain optimal internal conditions- Homeostasis, which is a negative feedback loop
 - Advantages- can go outside all the time
- Conformers- let internal environment match external environment
 - Advantages- use less energy
- Endotherms- maintain internal body temperature through metabolism (**metabolically**)
 - Endotherms eat food (reduced carbon), metabolize reduced carbon by oxidizing it (again), protons move across membranes into the mitochondria
 - Chemical energy → movement energy
- Ectotherms- body temperature is controlled by environment or behavior, not metabolism
- Smaller organisms require less energy
- Ectotherms has a larger change in metabolic rate per fold change in mass than endotherms because **larger animals have proportionately less surface area so they lose proportionately less heat, so they lose less energy**
- Aquatic carnivores require higher absolute amount of energy than terrestrial carnivores because they live in the water which is colder than land because it has a **higher specific heat** (meaning it takes more energy to heat up water than air)
- Size, basal metabolic rate, and surroundings all influence the energetic needs of organisms
