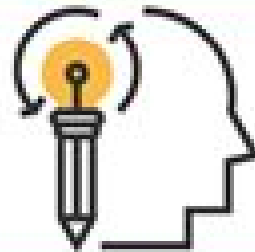


HOW TO CONDUCT OBSERVATIONS

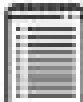
WHAT ARE OBSERVATIONS?

Observations are a type of ethnographic data collection method where researchers visit or participate in a location or with a group of people to better understand people, environments, interactions, behaviors, or other phenomena within the space.



WHEN SHOULD I CONDUCT INTERVIEWS FOR RESEARCH?

Observations are best when researchers are highly unfamiliar with a people or location and researchers hope to gain insights about how the people or environment act, respond, interact, behave, or otherwise engage.

 Determine what you want to observe and why. Are looking to see how students respond to a new environment? How customers interact with employees? How bosses interact with subordinates? When conducting observations you are trying to learn habits, patterns, behaviors, reactions, and general information about people in a particular environment to better understand what they do and, hopefully eventually, why they do it though observations alone often won't tell you the 'why'.	 To make observations most effective, it's important that you minimize or eliminate any disruptive or unfamiliar devices into the environment you wish to observe. For example, it is often least effective to videorecord observations in situations where the people being observed know they are being filmed (but it's usually unethical to film without telling them). Note-taking is the most common method, though in some public spaces you can take photographs, audio recordings, and other methods.	 Determine whether you are conducting an informal or a formal observation (see explanations to the far right). Knowing your objective, determine if there are specific questions you have or if you are going in completely open-minded. What you hope to learn will help you know what specifically to look for. Be prepared when entering an observation space by having a sound understanding of the type of information you are trying learn.	 Visit the space you are hoping to get information from. Be as unobtrusive as possible, taking notes, photographs, audio and film only where it is allowed, you have permission, and it makes sense for the research without disrupting the environment. If you are doing formal observations, will you need to code certain behaviors, actions, words, visual, and other observed data.	 Separate the difference between what you observed (which are factual behaviors) and why what you observed happened. Typically to make some sense of your observed data, you will need to interview people in the environment you are observing, either during the observation itself or afterwards. Make connections between interactions, responses, behaviors, and other phenomena.

INFORMAL OBSERVATIONS

Informal observations are conducted when you have little or no concept about what to expect, and you are simply going to observe people in order to learn about their behaviors. You enter these environments with a completely open mind hoping to gain some insight about the people in the environment. Often you may enter these informal observations with particular questions in mind, but you aren't necessarily seeking to codify data or follow strict checklists or time frames.

Informal observations are good for obtaining initial insights that can be later followed up with other types of research.

FORMAL OBSERVATIONS

Formal observations are structured, repeatable observations where researchers are looking for specific cues to codify and report. Researchers in formal observations will have identified in advance types of phrases, actions, settings, or other environmental surroundings to look for and will take note of each of them, codifying them in pre-determined ways. Formal observations often have checklists that researchers are following and they may be timed—meaning, researchers may be looking for what happens at different intervals.

Formal observations are good for repeated studies of behavior that can be duplicated for future research and quantified.

Exploring the Handling of Critical Work Practices in Rapid Change Contexts Ulrika Harlin, 2024-07-01 The accelerating pace of change in our society requires organisations to efficiently manage day to day operations while simultaneously innovating and developing new concepts for the future all within an environment of rapidly evolving circumstances Specifically organisations must quickly be able to handle the work practices that are critical to organisational development and this thesis focuses on the handling of these practices Critical work practices CWP are here defined as operational management practices that are quickly initiated or adjusted either scaled up or down in response to new developmental needs or emerging acute situations Commonly there are limitations to CWPs ingrained in previous structures methods or knowledge The thesis aims to explore the handling of CWPs in rapidly changing contexts and how this handling is enabled or constrained by the influencing organisational factors of active ownership stakeholder collaboration and developmental learning The empirical foundation of the thesis builds on an interactive research approach It utilises data from case studies in two rapid change contexts an industrial startup in the green transformation and organisations response during the initial stages of the COVID 19 pandemic Results from the studies show that organisations demonstrated agility by mobilising resources and fostering collaboration in novel ways guided by overarching objectives that transcended local concerns Identified CWPs were characterised by their innovative nature and various degrees of newness and time constraints which necessitated new approaches and provided opportunities for adaptive and developmental learning Three conclusions can be drawn from the analysis in the thesis first disruptive changes trigger entrepreneurship and innovations through enhanced space of action and seamless cross collaborations Second the interaction between intermediaries managers and employees fosters a holistic understanding and proactivity Third rapid change contexts stress test organisations where

strengths constraints and new opportunities become visualised Theoretically the thesis contributes with a conceptual model highlighting essential factors of organisational conditions and their interconnections An additional contribution is made in introducing the concept of CWPs and identifying prerequisites for handling different forms of such practices in rapid change contexts The practical implications of this research include that different types of CWPs are a source that can be utilised for continuous improvements supporting organisations ability to handle increasing uncertainties Moreover the conceptual model provides analytical support of work practices that intend to contribute to transitions related to development areas such as a circular economy electrification digitalisation and resilience
