failure at the Little Big Horn was LTG Sheridan's fault not LTC Custer's and this directly relates to the second finding. The second key finding is the importance of operational art in designing a campaign plan to link tactical actions to strategic objectives. Page iv *Unified Land Operations (ADRP 3-0)* Department of the Army, 2012-09-24 Army Doctrine Reference Publication ADRP 3-0 Unified Land Operations is the first ADRP released under Doctrine 2015. ADRP 3-0 expands on the foundations and tenets found in Army Doctrine Publication ADP 3-0. This ADRP expands on the doctrine of unified land operations found in ADP 3-0. The publication of ADP 3-0 shifted the Army's operational concept from full spectrum operations to unified land operations. The doctrine of unified land operations describes how the Army demonstrates its core competencies of combined arms maneuver and wide area security through decisive action. The term decisive action replaces the term full spectrum operations as the concept of continuous simultaneous offense defense stability or defense support of civil authorities. Defense support of civil authorities replaces civil support as a task under decisive action. ADRP 3-0 expands the discussion of the foundations and tenets of unified land operations as well as the operational framework found in ADP 3-0. Additional changes in ADRP 3-0 from the now obsolete 2011 FM 3-0 Change 1 include a discussion of the range of military operations replacing the spectrum of conflict as well as a discussion of information collection replacing intelligence reconnaissance and surveillance known as ISR. These changes in ADRP 3-0 now better align Army doctrine with the joint discussion of the principles of joint operations. ADRP 3-0 remains generally consistent with the now obsolete 2011 FM 3-0 Change 1 on key topics while adopting updated terminology and concepts as necessary. These topics include the discussion of an operational environment and the operational and mission variables as well as the discussions of unified action, law of land warfare and combat power. As in the now obsolete 2011 FM 3-0 Change 1, mission command remains both a philosophy of command and a warfighting function. Finally, ADRP 3-0 maintains combined arms as the application of arms that multiplies Army forces' effectiveness in all operations. ADRP 3-0 contains four chapters. Chapter 1 shortens the discussion of the operational environment found on the now obsolete 2011 FM 3-0 Change 1 and emphasizes military operations. This chapter provides a framework of variables of an operational environment that shape their nature and affect outcomes. The chapter then discusses unified action and joint operations as well as land operations. Finally, this chapter discusses law of land warfare and combined arms. Chapter 2 introduces the Army's new operational concept of unified land operations. It discusses how commanders apply landpower as part of unified action to defeat the enemy on land and establish conditions that achieve the

joint force commander's end state Chapter 2 discusses how commanders demonstrate the Army's new core competencies of combined arms maneuver and wide area security conducted through decisive action Chapter 3 discusses combat power and the warfighting functions used to generate combat power in support of unified land operations As in the now obsolete 2011 FM 3-0 Change 1 chapter 3 discusses the eight elements of combat power that include the six warfighting functions with leadership and information Lastly it discusses how Army forces achieve combined arms through force tailoring task organization and mutual support Chapter 4 discusses the elements of operational art and the meaning of operational art to Army forces It elaborates on commanders and staffs applying the elements of operational art to understand visualize and describe how to establish conditions to achieve a desired end state It discusses how operational art represents a creative approach to dealing with the direction of military forces and expresses an informed vision across the levels of war Army Doctrine Reference Publication Adrp 3-0 Operational October 2017 United States Government Us Army, 2017-10-09 This doctrine manual Army Doctrine Reference Publication ADRP 3-0 Operational October 2017 supports land operations doctrine established in ADP 3-0 Operations and is supported by FM 3-0 Operations This publication expands the overarching guidance on unified land operations It accounts for the uncertainty of operations and recognizes that a military operation is a human undertaking It constitutes the Army's view of how to conduct prompt and sustained operations on land and sets the foundation for developing other principles tactics techniques and procedures detailed in subordinate doctrine publications The principal audience for ADRP 3-0 is all members of the profession of arms Commanders and staffs of Army headquarters serving as joint task force or multinational headquarters should also refer to applicable joint or multinational doctrine concerning the range of military operations and joint or multinational forces Trainers and educators throughout the Army will use this publication as well ADRP 3-0 contains numerous changes to the November 2016 version the most significant of which are updates necessary to align with FM 3-0 Operations ADRP 3-0 modifies the definition of unified land operations to account for the consolidation of gains ADRP 3-0 adds the concept of a consolidation area to the operational framework Additional changes include a discussion of peer threats positions of relative advantage multi domain considerations and the consolidation of gains as an Army strategic role These all expand upon unified land operations ADRP 3-0 employs information such as principles and tenets as a means of highlighting key aspects of doctrine Where lists are employed a narrative discussion follows to provide details on the subject They serve as guidelines or tools for readers to more easily remember important doctrinal terms However there remains a need to study doctrine in detail and consider how terms are applied to operations ADRP 3-0 modifies key topics and updates terminology and concepts as necessary These topics include the discussion of an operational environment and the operational and mission variables as well as discussions of unified action law of land warfare and combat power Mission command remains both a philosophy of command and a warfighting function ADRP 3-0 contains five chapters Chapter 1 discusses military operations It describes the variables that shape the nature of an

Unified Land Operations Department of the Army, 2011-10-10 When we published Change 1 to the 2008 edition of Field Manual FM 3-0 we captured the most critical lessons of almost ten years of sustained land combat In this edition we not only reflect on the past but also look to an uncertain future Army Doctrine Publication ADP 3-0 Unified Land Operations provides a common operational concept for a future in which Army forces must be prepared to operate across the range of military operations integrating their actions with joint interagency and multinational partners as part of a larger effort Unified Land Operations is a natural intellectual outgrowth of past capstone doctrine AirLand battle recognized the three dimensional nature of modern warfare while full spectrum operations recognized the need to conduct a fluid mix of offensive defensive and stability operations simultaneously This publication builds on both these ideas adding that success requires fully integrating Army operations with the efforts of joint interagency and multinational partners The central idea of Unified Land Operations is that Army units seize retain and exploit the initiative to gain and maintain a position of relative advantage in sustained land operations to create conditions for favorable conflict resolution This central idea applies to all military operations offensive defensive and stability or defense support of civil authorities This unifying principle connects the various tasks Army forces may perform It adds the founding principles of flexibility integration lethality adaptability depth and synchronization It incorporates the principle that operational art is the connection between strategic objectives and tactical actions and provides a common construct for organizing military operations The construct consists of the Army operations process an operations framework for visualizing and describing operations and the warfighting functions ADP 3-0 serves as the common operational concept for the Army The central idea adapted to the unique conditions of each conflict represents the Army s unique contribution to unified action It must permeate our doctrine
