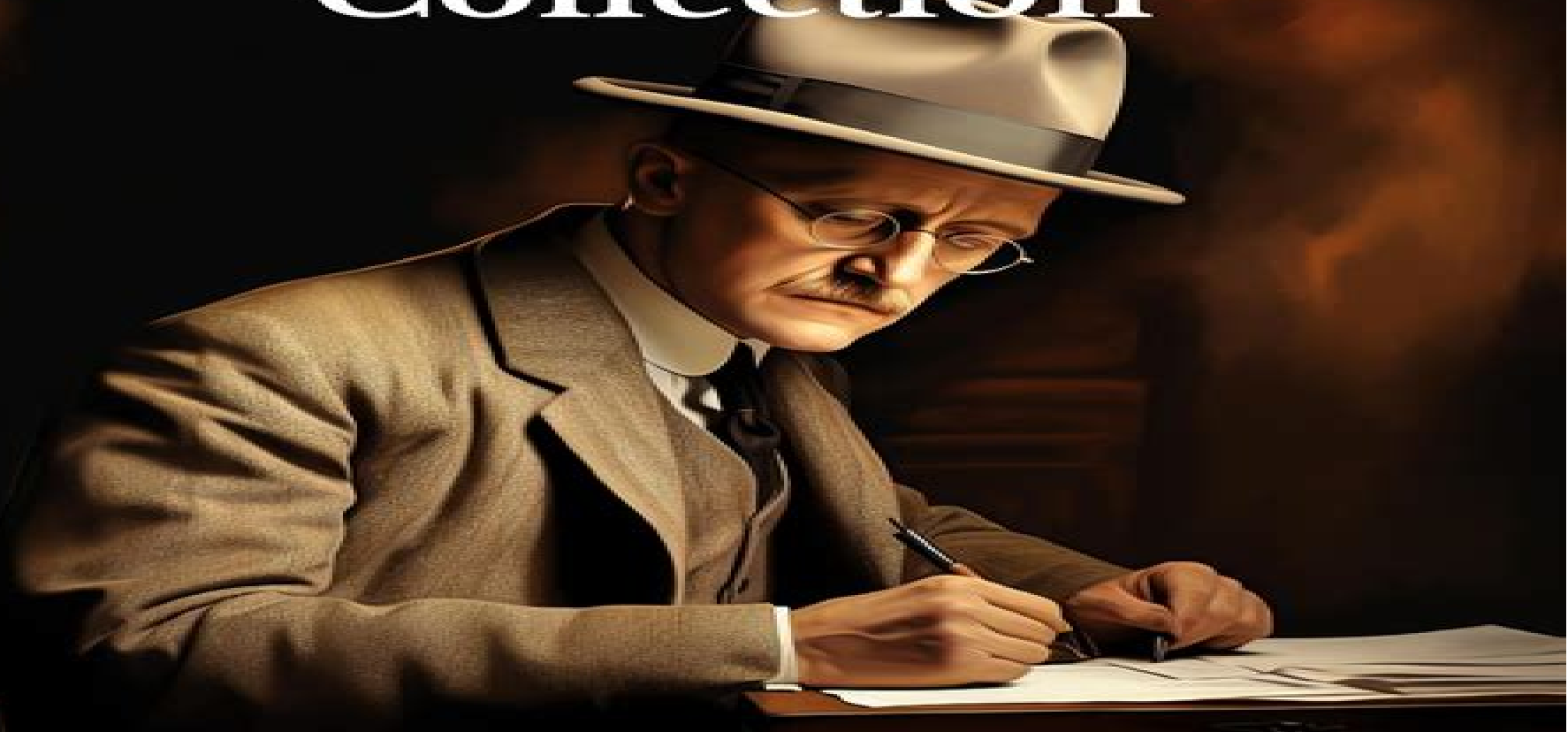

James Joyce, 2014-06-27 James Augustine Aloysius Joyce 1882-1941 was an Irish novelist and poet considered to be one of the most influential writers in the modernist avant-garde of the early 20th century. Joyce is best known for *Ulysses* (1922), a landmark work in which the episodes of Homer's *Odyssey* are paralleled in an array of contrasting literary styles, perhaps most prominent among these the stream of consciousness technique he perfected. Other major works are the short story collection *Dubliners* (1914) and the novels *A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man* (1916) and *Finnegans Wake* (1939). His complete oeuvre includes three books of poetry, a play, occasional journalism, and his published letters.
