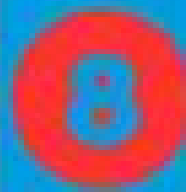

argues that students must not only be allowed to flex their whole language repertoires to learn and communicate but also be aware of how to build bridges across differences in individual repertoires. It offers suggestions for teachers to consider within their own contexts highlighting the need for teacher autonomy to cultivate the classroom community's critical language awareness and create conducive environments for learning.
