Tamar Kamionkowski, 2022-11-28 The book of Leviticus provides two different theologies related to God's presence within ancient Israel Leviticus 1-16 was written by an elite caste of priests P and Leviticus 17-26 H was added to the book to democratize access to God While the Priestly work has hardly inspired lay readers the Holiness Writings provide some of the most inspiring and well known verses from the Bible This volume shows how gender dynamics shift between the static worldview of P and the dynamic approach of H and that ironically as holiness expands from the priests to the people from the temple to the land of Israel gender behaviors become more highly regulated This complicates associations between power and gender dynamics and opens the door to questions about the relationships between power gender and theological perspectives

First Steps in the Talmud Jacob Neusner, 2012-07-10 The Talmud is a confusing piece of writing It begins nowhere and ends nowhere but it does not move in a circle It is written in several languages and follows rules that in certain circumstances trigger the use of one language over others Its components are diverse To translating it requires elaborate complementary language It cannot be translated verbatim into any language So a translation is a commentary in the most decisive way The Talmud accordingly cannot be merely read but only studied It contains diverse

programs of writing some descriptive and some analytical A large segment of the writing follows a clear pattern but the document encompasses vast components of miscellaneous collections of bits and pieces odds and ends It is a mishmash and a mess Yet it defines the program of study of the community of Judaism and governs the articulation of the norms and laws of Judaism its theology and its hermeneutics Above all else the Talmud of Babylonia is comprised of contention and produces conflict and disagreement with little effort at a resolution No wonder the Talmud confuses its audience But that does not explain the power of the Talmud to define Judaism and shape its intellect This book guides those puzzled by the Talmud and shows the system and order that animate the text **And Their Eyes Were Opened** Ray McAllister, 2021-10-15 This book

Priestly Rule Nathan MacDonald,2015-07-31 Whilst prophetic oracles in late prophetic books evidence tensions about the Jerusalem temple and its priesthood MacDonald demonstrates that the relationships between prophetic oracles have been incorrectly appraised Employing an interpretative method attentive to issues of redaction and inner biblical interpretation MacDonald show that Ezekiel 44 is a polemical response to Isaiah 56 and not the reverse as is typically assumed This has significant consequences for the dating of Ezekiel 44 and for its relationship to other biblical texts especially Pentateuchal texts from Leviticus and Numbers Since Ezekiel 44 has been a crucial chapter in understanding the historical development of the priesthood MacDonald s arguments affect our understanding of the origins of the distinction between Levites and priests and the claims that a Zadokite priestly sept dominated the Second Temple hierarchy
