furious and even more so when he learns that Theodore meets a lady at Alfonso s grave Manfred convinced that Isabella is having an affair with Theodore sneaks into the grave and fatally stabs the lady Horrified Manfred realizes that she has not killed Isabella but her own daughter Matilda Moments after Matilda s death the castle wall behind Manfred collapses revealing a gigantic vision of Alfonso Alfonso s image declares that his grandson Theodore is the true heir of Otranto Manfred then reveals that his grandfather poisoned Alfonso and usurped his throne In an attempt to atone for his wrongdoing Manfred agrees to abdicate the throne The novel ends with Frederic offering Isabella s hand in marriage to Theodore Although he eventually agrees to marry Isabella Theodore mourns the loss of his true love Matilda for many years
