Would you want to be in your classroom?

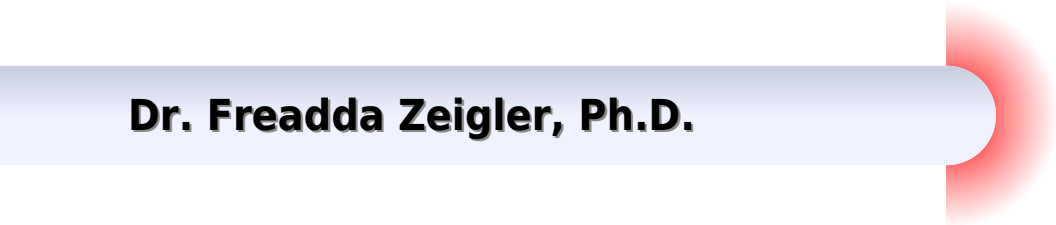
If you could be a student in any other person on our team's classroom who would it be and why? Schedule an observation in their room.
