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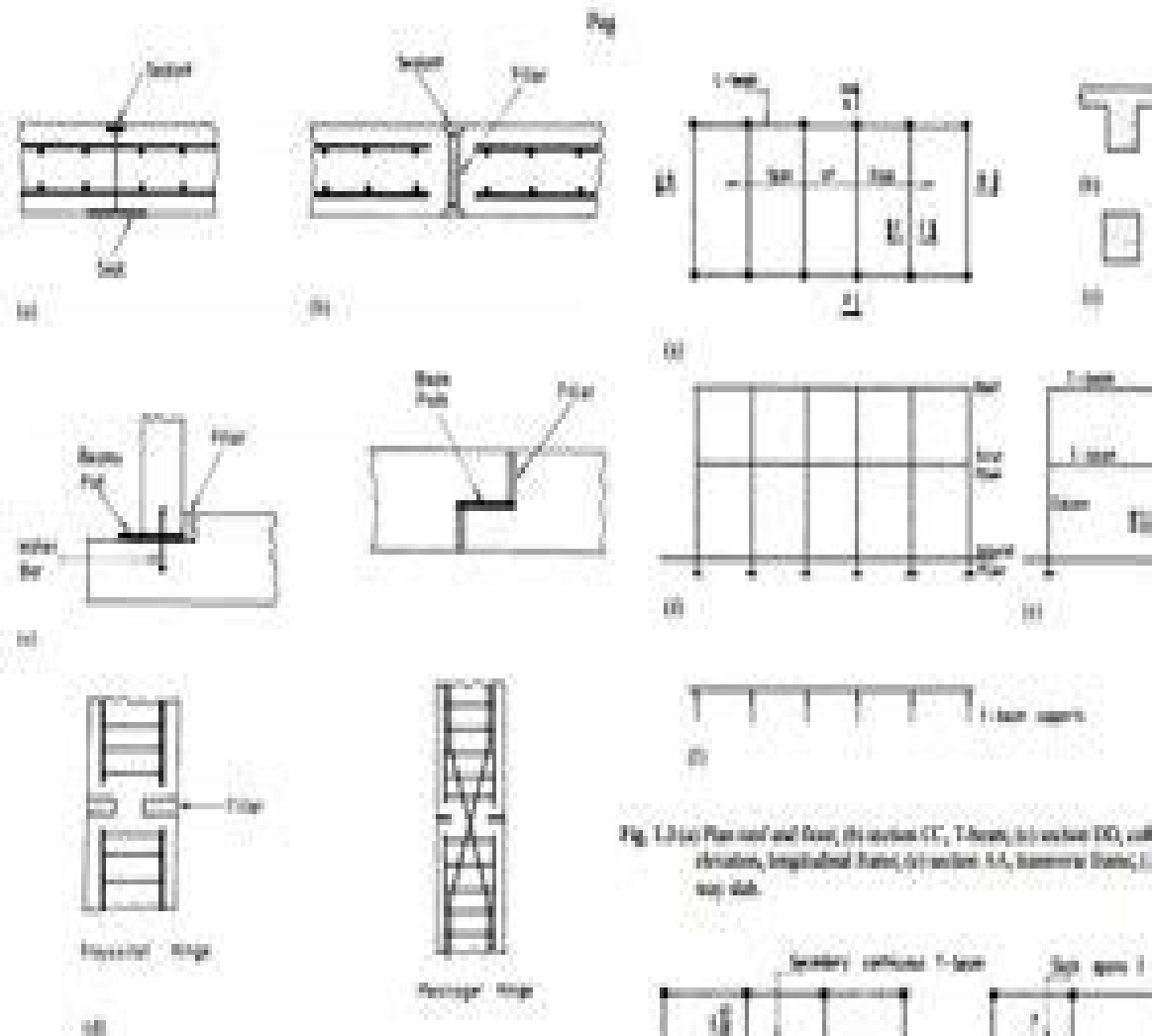


Fig. 1.1 (a) Plan view and (b) section CC, T-beam; (c) section DD, wall elevation; (d) section EE, wall elevation; (e) section FF, wall elevation; (f) section GG, wall elevation; (g) section HH, wall elevation; (h) section II, wall elevation; (i) section JJ, wall elevation; (j) section KK, wall elevation; (k) section LL, wall elevation; (l) section MM, wall elevation; (m) section NN, wall elevation; (n) section OO, wall elevation; (o) section PP, wall elevation; (p) section QQ, wall elevation; (q) section RR, wall elevation; (r) section SS, wall elevation; (s) section TT, wall elevation; (t) section UU, wall elevation; (u) section VV, wall elevation; (v) section WW, wall elevation; (w) section XX, wall elevation; (x) section YY, wall elevation; (y) section ZZ, wall elevation; (z) section AA, wall elevation.

(c) Overloading

Extreme overloading will cause cracking and eventual collapse. Factors of safety in the original design allow for possible overloads but vigilance is always required to ensure that the structure is never grossly overloaded. A change in function of building or room can lead to overloading, e.g.

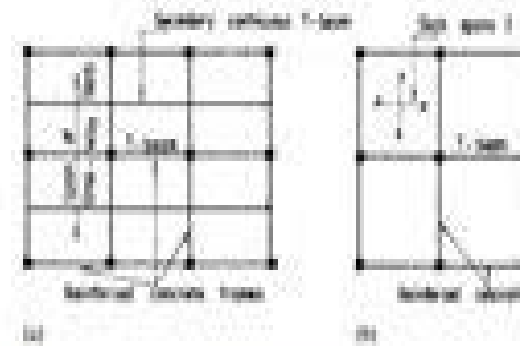


Fig. 1.3 (a) Two-way floor slab, (b) two-way floor slab
